

INVITATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF APPRENTICE OFFICIAL FOR 63rd NSCC BHOPAL

Anyone, who is holder of ISSF “B” Jury license (but doesn't have enough experience) or has passed ISSF course in April 2019, is eligible to officiate during 63rd NSCC in Rifle/Pistol events at Bhopal as an “apprentice official”. The following are the terms and conditions for officiating

- a. The official must have a valid ISSF “B” Jury/Judges licence or have passed the ISSFCourse successfully.
- b. The official will submit a written request to NRAI expressing his/her willingness to officiate during selection trials/competitions.
- c. NRAI will pay a sum of Rs. 1000/- per day as “Apprenticeship allowance” on actual days of officiating. NRAI would provide tea/snacks/lunch, free of charge, during the days of officiating at range. No boarding/lodging/local transport or travel allowance will be paid.
- d. The official will not be permitted to participate in 63rd NSCC.
- e. This will be considered as one of the five minimum trials/competitions organized by NRAI for empanelment as “Regular official” subject to fulfilling the following parameters:

1. Discipline
2. Punctuality
3. Knowledge/implementation of rules
4. Fairness
5. Dealing with shooters/fellow officials
6. Willingness to learn
7. Loyalty for Shooting Sport

The officials, interested to officiate during 63rd NSCC from 7th December 2019 to 4th January 2020 may send their applications to the Secretary General, NRAI before 10th November 2019 for consideration. The email ID is indiashooting@gmail.com
