INVITATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF APPRENTICE OFFICIALS

Anyone, who is holder of ISSF "B" Jury license (but doesn't have enough experience) or has passed ISSF course in April 2019, is eligible to officiate during the selection trials/competitions organized by NRAI as an "apprentice official". The following are the terms and conditions for officiating

- a. The official must have a valid ISSF "B" Jury/Judges licence or have passed the ISSF Course successfully.
- b. The official will submit a written request to NRAI expressing his/her willingness to officiate during selection trials/competitions.
- c. NRAI will pay a sum of Rs. 500/- per day as "Apprenticeship allowance" on actual days of officiating. NRAI would provide tea/snacks/lunch, free of charge, during the days of officiating at range. No boarding/lodging/local transport or travel allowance will be paid.
- d. The official will not be permitted to participate in selection trial/competitions as and when he/she is officiating
- e. The official, after officiating in minimum five selection trials/competitions organized by NRAI, will be empanelled as "Regular official" subject to fulfilling the following parameters:
- 1. Discipline
- 2. Punctuality
- 3. Knowledge/implementation of rules
- 4. Fairness
- 5. Dealing with shooters/fellow officials
- 6. Willingness to learn
- 7. Loyalty for Shooting Sport

A record of such officials, rendering services will be maintained by NRAI and on completion of five selection trials/competitions, the profile of official will be assessed. Persons fulfilling the above parameters would be empanelled for rendering services as Regular official.

The officials, interested to officiate during 19th KSS Memorial Shooting Championship and Trial 5 from 16th June 2019 onwards may send their applications to the Secretary General, NRAI before 20th May 2019 for consideration.
