RE: Update following ISSF/CGF Meeting – December 2019

Dear Dr. Batra,

Following on from our successful meetings, with you and your colleagues in November, and our subsequent meeting with the ISSF in Munich in early December. I am pleased to inform you that the ISSF and the National Rifle Association of Indian have expressed interest in hosting a Commonwealth Shooting event in India prior to the Games in Birmingham 2022. Their joint proposal briefly outlined during our meeting with them this month; subject to careful examination and ratification by the various competent levels within the Commonwealth Games Federation', and assuming such a proposal would be in conformity with our constitution and regulations; would in our opinion substantively meet the expectations of all stake holders including those of India effectively.

The NRAI will work with you and the Government of India to develop a formal submission to the CGF for consideration early January by the CGF Sports Committee and then to the CGF Executive Board for approval. This proposal must be formally endorsed and submitted by the Indian Commonwealth Games Association as the official member of the CGF.

We were very encouraged by the engagement and leadership taken by Mr Vladimir Lisin, ISSF President, and Mr. Raninder Singh, NRAI President, and we look forward to supporting them with your endorsement in developing their innovative proposal.

We thank you for your support and continued collaboration.
