TRAIN THE TRAINERS COURSE

NRAI, the apex body of shooting sports in India, in its effort to promote shooting sports in the country has decided to open approximately 200 training centers in the country in next 2 years. To make such centers functional and result oriented, it is pertinent to have adequate number of trainers with the desired level of proficiency and competence. It is with this view that the NRAI has decided to conduct courses for the training of trainers in 10M Air Weapon category. The tenth course is commencing from 11th March 2015.

AIM- Aim of this course is to train selected candidates from school, colleges and other institutions as trainers for beginners in 10 M Air Weapon Category.

SCOPE- Scope of this course will be to highlight the history of Indian Shooting Sports, introduction to 10M Air Weapon Range and weapon maintenance, safety, rules & regulations, word of command, coaching technique, etc.

COURSE DURATION- The course will be conducted for 5 days including test/examination.

COURSE FEE AND ADMINISTRATIVE DETAILS- This 5 days certification course has been priced at Rs. 8,500/- per candidate (which will include all taxes, cost of course material, tea and lunch on course days, and other allied charges during the course).

COURSE VENUE - The course will be conducted at the 10M Shooting Range at Guru Harkrishan Public School, Road No. 73, West Punjabi Bagh, New Delhi - 110026 which is situated near the Punjabi Bagh Club.

EXAMINATION AND ISSUE OF CERTIFICATE- At end of the course proper examination to evaluate the proficiency attained by the students will be held and certificates to the successful candidates will be awarded by the National Rifle Association of India. This certificate will be valid for three years which will further be renewed after upgradation capsule.

APPLICATION FORM AND AFFIDAVIT- All candidates are required to submit application duly completed in all respects and affidavit as per the enclosed format with 3 passport size photographs.

COURSE FEE AND MODE OF PAYMENT - The course fee is required to be paid in advance through bank draft in favour of "National Rifle Association of India" payable at New Delhi to be sent with the complete application form and documents to The National Rifle Association of India, 'NRAI' House, 51-B, Tughlakabad Institutional Area, New Delhi - 110062.
