SUB: STAGING OF XXXV All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship 2026 in Pistol events at Trishul Shooting Range, Maharana Pratap Sports College, Raipur, Dehradun, Uttarakhand from 23rd October to 1st November, 2026.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The XXXV All India G. V. Mavlankar Shooting Championship 2026 in Pistol events will be held at Trishul Shooting Range, Maharana Pratap Sports College, Raipur, Dehradun, Uttarakhand from 23rd October to 1st November, 2026 as detailed in the program attached. This Championship will be conducted by U.P. State Rifle Association under the aegis of the National Rifle Association of India and as per rules and regulations under NRAI Match Book.

Those competitors, who want to participate in this Championship, are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for their own convenience and to ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above Championship. All the matches will be conducted according to NRAI Match Book. The Match Book is available on our website www.thenrai.in

Athlete is eligible to participate in XXXV AIGVMSC only if he/she has achieved the following minimum qualifying scores as per Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book in the previous AIGVMSC, Zonal Championship or State Championship (Full course as per NRAI Match Book), conducted by the State Rifle Association in those events in which he/she wishes to participate. Please refer to rule 1.6 of NRAI Match Book as Annexure “B” as attached. Scores of such competitions must be filled at the time of filing online entry for AIGVMSC. **Athletes furnishing wrong information shall be debarred from taking part in any Championship for two years.**

Athletes who failed to maintain the Minimum Qualifying Scores as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book during previous NSCC will enter in Matches for MQS only and will not be eligible for any Medal/Ranking. Please see Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match Book.

The age eligibility for all age category events shall be determined as on 31st December of the year in which the competition commences and shall remain unchanged for the entire duration of the competition. (age criteria as per ISSF Rule 3.7.4.12) Athletes, who are completing the age, as stated 31st December of the year in which the competition commence will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Sub Youth - 16 years or before	Born in 2010 or after
Youth - 19 years or before	Born in year 2007 or after
Juniors – 21 years	Born in year 2005 or after
Seniors	Born in year 2004 or before
Masters – 45 to 59 years	Born between year 1967 to 1981
Senior Masters – 60 to 69 years	Born between year 1957 to 1966
Super Masters – 70 years	Born in year 1956 or before

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP. SIMILARLY, ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 10 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN AIR WEAPON EVENTS.

For Deaf Athletes– There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf athletes may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf athletes.

For Para Athletes - All athletes who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category

Athletes, who participated in previous NSCC but failed to achieve MQS under 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, must file their entry in MQS category failing which they will be disqualified as per Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match Book. Athletes, who achieved MQS those events as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book latest in 67th /68th NSCC are not eligible to participate in those events in MQS or other category in Zonal or AIGVMSC.

ATHLETES HAVE NOT PARTICIPATED IN ANY NSCC ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN NR (INDIVIDUAL) MATCHES

THE ATHLETE WHO HAS NOT PARTICIPATED IN THE CURRENT STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AND HAVE NOT ACHIEVE MQS AS PER RULE 1.4 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN XXXV ALL INDIA G V MAVLANKAR SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP BASED ON THEIR PERFORMANCE IN INDIA OPEN COMPETITION.

Athletes, who have not received/ applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.

The representation and entry for participation in XXXV All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship 2026 in Pistol events is as per Rule 6 of NRAI Match Book. The athlete would represent the State as per their registration on NRAI's "Online system". Entries will be accepted on NRAI portal www.thenrai.org The last dates for accepting entries are as under:

With normal fee	–	7 th October, 2026 till 7.30 pm
With triple fee	–	8 th October, 2026 till 7.30 pm

Athletes, who achieved scores as per rule 1.4. of NRAI Match Book, are eligible to participate in this Championship. Athletes achieving scores as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book (as amended from time to time) will be allowed to participate in 69th NSCC. The details are attached as Annexure B. List of Matches is attached as per Annexure "C". Copy of the NRAI Match Book is available on the website of NRAI www.thenrai.in .

Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid "online" and no cash/draft will be accepted. Athletes will be permitted to shoot only in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. Protest fee is Rs.354/- including 18% GST). Penalty of Rs. 236/- including 18% GST will be charged if an athlete loses his/her competitor card during the competition and fresh card will only be issued on deposit of penalty.

The State Rifle Associations/Units will be imposed a penalty of Rs. 3000/-(plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/-) per Athlete in case their athletes score below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during Zonal Championship under Rule 16.15 of NRAI Match Book. The State/Unit must remit the penalty amount with NRAI immediately otherwise athletes from that unit/state will not be allowed to participate in any competition conducted by NRAI. The Secretary General may also call for explanation of the unit/state for sending such shooters. Athletes participating in AIGVMSC on the basis of their performance during any competition conducted by NRAI shall be exempted.

In case athlete is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.5900/-, as applicable) shall be imposed on the athlete and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The athlete will be allowed to participate in other events of the NSCC only after payment of penalty amount.

IMPORTANT

Only three (3) athletes will be allowed to use common weapon. The names of athlete likely to use common weapon should be intimated together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable to work out the details for the conduct of the relevant matches.

ACCOMMODATION

There are vast range of hotel's available in Dehradun. Athletes are requested to contact hotels directly for their bookings.

AMMUNITION

Ammunition will be issued against valid arm license of Association/Club/Individual or special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity must be obtained from the local licensing authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds must be returned to NRAI/Organizers. No arms will be provided by NRAI/Organizers.

FOR PARA ATHLETES

Athletes who achieve MQS will be eligible to participate in 69th NSCC. Athletes who achieve MQS as per Annexure "B" will be notified as "Renowned athlete" and they will also be eligible for grant of Import permit for Import of their equipment's. List of NR Matches as per Annexure "B" attached.

All athletes, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category.

FOR DEAF ATHLETES

There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf athletes may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf athletes..

Participation in Deaf category is restricted to athletes who must be Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 db PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard)

1. Athletes wanting to participate in Deaf category for the first time have to email their Disability Certificate/Audiogram from Govt. Hospital to Technical Director/Coach, email ID anujajung@gmail.com or WhatsApp Mobile Number 09868206320, for verification by Coach and AISCD (All India Sport Council of the Deaf)
2. Athletes whose disability certificates have been verified earlier do not need to verify again.
3. Entry in Deaf category will be accepted online. Email match no. to anujajung@gmail.com verification of documents.
4. Deaf athletes can also participate in General category events as per MQS achieved, for the event to participate in. Entry in General Category should be submitted directly on the NRAI's online system.
5. Scores achieved by deaf athletes in General category will be considered for MQS in Deaf category. (Copies of Clauses 1.4 and 17.6 are attached herewith at Annexure "C" for your ready reference. List of matches is at Annexure "D".

AWARD OF MEDALS

The medals will be awarded in individual category as follows:

- 4 Athletes 3 Medals
- 3 Athletes 2 Medals
- 2 Athlete 1 Medal
- 1 Athlete no Medal

Medals/Badges will not be awarded to those, whose score is less than the qualifying marks as prescribed for the relevant matches irrespective of their individual position. The grading of those securing above the qualifying marks will be done as usual. **This will not apply to the athletes under Deaf, Para, Senior Masters and Super Masters category. (AS PER RULE NO. 10.3 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK)**

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
2. Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of working at ranges
3. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
4. Follow directions by officials.
5. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
6. Be disciplined on and off the field.
7. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
8. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
9. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
10. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
11. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
12. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
13. It's the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
14. Athlete is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
15. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
16. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
17. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
18. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
19. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.

The NRAI/Organizing Committee reserve the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by NRAI/Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the Competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules. Half pants/Jeans and chapels are not permitted on the range.
