GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZERS

- a) **The 011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION (SHOTGUN) and *Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup***, sponsored by M/s Beretta, will be conducted by the National Rifle Association of India at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Tughlakabad, New Delhi.

2. NAME OF THE COMPETITION

011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION and ***Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup***, sponsored by Beretta.

3. VENUE

DR. KARNI SINGH SHOOTING RANGES, TUGHLAKABAD, NEW DELHI

4. COMPETITION DATES

NR MATCHES FROM 5TH TO 7TH OCTOBER, 2026

Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup, sponsored by M/s Beretta from 8-13 October 2026

5. LEVEL OF COMPETITION

The Level of the India Open Competition is Pre-National Level Competition as defined under NRAI Match Book. The ***Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup*** is a sponsored competition by M/s Beretta.

6. CONDUCT OF COMPETITION

- a) The NR Matches will be conducted in accordance with NRAI Match Book under NR Rules and ISSF Rules. The NRAI shall conduct ***Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup***, sponsored by M/s Beretta as per rules stated below.

7. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Eligibility for Participate in India Open Competition

- a) Athletes who have participated in Pre-State Championship/State Championship/AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/India Open Competition or in NSCC are eligible to participate in NR matches during this Competition. In case any State Rifle Association fails to conduct the Pre-State Championship, the NRAI reserves the right to allow athletes of that State to participate in India Open Competition.
- b) Athletes achieving MQS (NR) under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, as per Annexure “A” during one of the India Open Competitions, will be eligible to participate in 69th NSCC.
- c) Athletes may participate in multiple India Open Competitions to achieve MQS for participation in 69th NSCC. Athlete having one MQS, as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book (NR), will be eligible to participate in 69th NSCC even if he/she fails to achieve MQS in subsequent competitions including AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMMPIONSHIPS.
- d) Athletes are not eligible to participate in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship, based on the performance during in the India Open Competition (IOC)
- e) A penalty of Rs. 3000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/- or as applicable) per event will be imposed on athlete in case athlete's score is below 85% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during the Competition. The State/Unit must recover this amount from the athletes. The State Rifle Association will be responsible for recovery of penalty and deposit the same with NRAI. Athletes will not be permitted to participate in any competition till the penalty amount is paid to NRAI.
- f) In case athlete is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus 18% GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the athlete and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The athlete will be allowed to participate in other events only after payment of penalty amount.

8. REPRESENTATION AND ENTRY

The representation and entry for participation in 011 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION is as per Rule 6 of NRAI Match Book. The athlete would represent the State as per their registration on NRAI's "Online system". Entries will be accepted on NRAI portal www.thenrai.org The last dates for accepting entries are as under:

With normal fee	28th September, 2026, till 7.30 pm
With triple fee	29th September, 2026 till 7.30 pm

BERETTA 500 YEAR ANNIVERSARY GOLD CUP (ISSF MATCHES):

Entries for the Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup (ISSF matches) shall be accepted on the NRAI portal until the maximum number of entries specified under Clause 18(d) is reached, or 28th September, 2026 till 7.30 pm, whichever is earlier. Upon reaching the prescribed maximum number of entries for any discipline, entries for that discipline shall stand closed, irrespective of the date or time.

9. AGE CRITERIA & CATEGORIES

The age eligibility for all age category events shall be determined as on 31st December of the year in which the competition commences and shall remain unchanged for the entire duration of the competition. (age criteria as per ISSF Rule 3.7.4.12)

Athletes, who are completing the age, as stated 31st December of the year in which the competition commence will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Youth - 19 years or before	Born in year 2007 or after
Juniors – 21 years	Born in year 2005 or after
Seniors	Born in year 2004 or before
Masters – 45 to 59 years	Born between year 1967 to 1981
Senior Masters – 60 to 69 years	Born between year 1957 to 1966
Super Masters – 70 years	Born in year 1956 or before

Youth, Juniors may participate in Senior Category. Similarly, the Super Masters may participate in all age category matches except junior and Youth category. Senior Masters may participate in Masters and Seniors category. Masters can participate in Senior category. Participation in various categories is with the payment of additional entry fee as Per rule.

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

10. LIST OF EVENTS

All categories for NR matches for Men and Women (As per Annexure A)

11. AWARD OF MEDALS

- Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal will be awarded in each category in individual events.
- Individual medals will be awarded on the basis of Qualification Scores in all categories.**
- Rule 10 of NRAI Match Book will apply for award of medals.

12. ENTRY FEE Per Match

FOR NR MATCHES

Single Entry fee – Rs.2000/- plus 18% GST = Rs.2360/-
Triple Entry fee -- Rs.2000/- X 3 = Rs.6000/- + 18% GST
= Rs.7080/-

13. AMMUNITON

Ammunition will be issued against valid arm license of Association/Club/Individual or special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization or jurisdiction of arm license, special permits for the required quantity and area jurisdiction must be obtained from the local licensing authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds must be returned to NRAI.

No arms will be provided by NRAI/Organizers.

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- (plus 18%) Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-(plus 18% GST) Rs.590/-.

16. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels for all budgets are available in New Delhi.

17. GENERAL

All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance:

- All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- Athletes are required to print their competitor cards and Equipment Control Form and bring the same with them at the time of participation, failing which Rs. 200/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.236/-) will be collected for each card/form, if supplied by NRAI.
- In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries, entry fee will not be refunded.
- Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final.
- All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.

18. CONDUCT OF BERETTA 500 YEAR ANNIVERSARY GOLD CUP

The Beretta is sponsoring **Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup**. The following conditions shall apply separately and independently to conduct **Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup** in Trap and Skeet events. Mr. Mansher Singh, eminent athlete has very kindly agree to coordinate the event sponsorship and operational arrangements for Beretta 500 Years Anniversary Gold Cup

The following conditions shall apply separately and independently to the conduct of the Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup in Trap (ISSF) and Skeet (ISSF) events.

a. Participation in One Category Only

Each athlete shall be permitted to participate in only ONE category within each discipline. An athlete shall not be permitted to enter or compete in more than one category within the same discipline.

b. Categories of Participation

For both Trap (ISSF) and Skeet (ISSF), the competition shall comprise the following categories:

- International Men
- International Junior Men
- Renowned Shot Men
- Renowned Shot Master Men
- Renowned Shot Senior Master Men
- Renowned Shot Super Master Men
- Renowned Shot Junior Men
- Renowned Shot Youth Men
- International Women
- International Junior Women
- Renowned Shot Women
- Renowned Shot Master Women
- Renowned Shot Senior Master Women
- Renowned Shot Super Master Women
- Renowned Shot Junior Women
- Renowned Shot Youth Women

c. Categorization of Athletes

- i. **International Shooter:** Any athlete, as defined under Rule 1.1.6 of the NRAI Match Book, and has participated in an international shooting competition at any time during his/her shooting career shall be considered an International Shooter and shall be eligible to enter only the applicable International category—International Men, International Junior Men, International Women or International Junior Women, as applicable. Such an athlete shall not be eligible to enter any Renowned Shot category.

- ii. **Renowned Shooter:** Any athlete who has been designated or recognised as a Renowned Shot at any time during his/her shooting career from 2018 till date shall be required to enter only the applicable Renowned Shot category — Renowned Shot Men, Renowned Shot Master Men, Renowned Shot Senior Master Men, Renowned Shot Super Master Men, Renowned Shot Women, Renowned Shot Master Women, Renowned Shot Senior Master Women or Renowned Shot Super Master Women, as applicable.
- iii. **Foreign Shooter:** Any foreign national participating in the competition shall be eligible to participate only in the applicable International Category — International Men, International Junior Men, International Women or International Junior Women, as applicable.
- iv. **An athlete falling under either of the above classifications shall not be permitted to enter any other category, irrespective of his/her age or previous participation in another category.**

IMPORTANT CAUTION FOR INTERNATIONAL SHOOTERS:

As per Rule 1.1.6 of the NRAI Match Book, any athlete who qualifies as an International Shooter and has participated in an international shooting competition at any time during his/her shooting career shall be eligible to enter ONLY the applicable International Category. Any entry submitted by such an athlete in any category other than the applicable International Category shall be rejected outright, without any further explanation or correspondence.

- v. **Age Criteria** – The age criteria as per Rule 9 above shall be applicable.

d. Maximum Number of Entries per Event

The maximum number of entries permitted in the Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup shall be:

Trap (ISSF): 210 entries

Skeet (ISSF): 150 entries

The above limits shall apply across all categories combined. Irrespective of the number of athletes entered in any individual category, the total number of entries in each discipline shall not exceed the maximum limit specified above.

ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON A “FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED” BASIS ONLY

e. Qualification Rounds

All athletes shall participate in five qualification rounds in their respective category and discipline. The ranking in each category shall be determined on the basis of the aggregate qualification score achieved over the five rounds. Youth Men and Youth Women shall participate in all five qualification rounds and shall be ranked on the basis of their aggregate qualification scores; however, they shall not be eligible to qualify for or participate in the Final.

f. Qualification for the Final

At the conclusion of the five qualification rounds, the following categories shall be merged for the purpose of qualification for the Final:

- **International Men / International Junior Men / Renowned Shot Junior Men** – The athlete achieving the highest aggregate qualification score across all three categories, irrespective of the category in which the athlete competed, shall qualify for the Final. **(1 Finalist from these 3 combined categories)**
- **International Women / International Junior Women / Renowned Shot Junior Women** – The athlete achieving the highest aggregate qualification score across all three categories, irrespective of the category in which the athlete competed, shall qualify for the Final. **(1 Finalist from these 3 combined categories)**
- **Renowned Shot Master Men / Renowned Shot Senior Master Men / Renowned Shot Super Master Men** – The athlete achieving the highest aggregate qualification score across all three categories, irrespective of the category in which the athlete competed, shall qualify for the Final. **(1 Finalist from these 3 combined categories)**
- **Renowned Shot Master Women / Renowned Shot Senior Master Women / Renowned Shot Super Master Women** – The athlete achieving the highest aggregate qualification score across all three categories, irrespective of the category in which the athlete competed, shall qualify for the Final. **(1 Finalist from these 3 combined categories)**
- **Renowned Shot Men** – The two athletes achieving the highest aggregate qualification scores in the Renowned Shot Men category shall qualify for the Final. **(2 Finalists from this single category)**
- **Renowned Shot Women** – The two athletes achieving the highest aggregate qualification scores in the Renowned Shot Women category shall qualify for the Final. **(2 Finalists from this single category)**

A total of 8 (eight) athletes shall qualify for the Final.

Youth Men and Youth Women shall participate in the five qualification rounds but shall not be eligible to qualify for or participate in the Final.

For the avoidance of doubt, where categories are merged for the purpose of the Final, the athlete with the highest aggregate qualification score across the relevant merged categories shall qualify, subject to the number of Finalists specified for each qualification group. No athlete competing in the Youth category shall be eligible for the Final.

g. Tie in Qualification Score

In case of a tie in the aggregate qualification score where the tie affects a position required for qualification for the Final, a shoot-off shall be conducted amongst the tied athletes in accordance with the applicable rules.

In the International Men / International Junior Men / Renowned Shot Junior Men, International Women / International Junior Women / Renowned Shot Junior Women, Renowned Shot Master Men / Renowned Shot Senior Master Men / Renowned Shot Super Master Men, and Renowned Shot Master Women / Renowned Shot Senior Master Women / Renowned Shot Super Master Women qualification groups, where a tie affects the position for qualification, a shoot-off shall be conducted amongst the tied athletes, and the athlete securing the higher position in the shoot-off shall qualify for the Final.

In the Renowned Shot Men and Renowned Shot Women categories, where a tie affects either of the two qualifying positions, a shoot-off shall be conducted amongst the tied athletes to determine the two athletes qualifying for the Final from each category.

The number of athletes qualifying from each category or merged qualification group shall be limited to the number of Finalists specified under Clause 18(f)

h. Composition of the Final

There shall be only ONE Final in each discipline.

The Final shall comprise eight athletes in total, selected from the six Final-qualifying groups as specified under Clause 18(f).

Thus, there shall be one common Final for the eight qualifying athletes in Trap (ISSF) and one common Final for the eight qualifying athletes in Skeet (ISSF). No separate Final shall be conducted for individual categories.

i. Youth Categories

The Youth Men and Youth Women categories shall consist of the five qualification rounds only.

Athletes competing in these two categories shall be eligible to participate in the qualification rounds and shall be ranked on the basis of their aggregate qualification scores. However, they shall not be eligible to qualify for or participate in the Final.

j. Final Eligibility

An athlete may enter the Final only if he/she has secured a qualifying position in one of the six designated Final-qualifying groups at the conclusion of the five qualification rounds, including, where applicable, by winning the shoot-off conducted to resolve a tie.

As each athlete is permitted to participate in only one category within a discipline, no athlete may qualify for the Final through more than one category within that discipline.

k. Open Category

At the conclusion of the five qualification rounds, the qualification scores of all athletes participating in the six Final-qualifying groups shall be combined and considered together for the purpose of determining the Open Category ranking.

This combined ranking shall be referred to as the Open Category and shall be determined separately for Trap (ISSF) and Skeet (ISSF).

The Open Category ranking shall be based solely on the aggregate qualification scores achieved at the conclusion of the five qualification rounds.

l. Gun Trophy – Highest Qualification Score

The athlete securing the highest aggregate qualification score in the Open Category shall be awarded a Gun Trophy as a prize for achieving the highest overall qualification score. The award of the Gun Trophy shall be independent of the athlete's qualification and position in the Final.

If the athlete awarded the Gun Trophy for the highest qualification score subsequently finishes in a position in the Final for which a Gun Trophy is to be awarded, that athlete shall not be eligible to receive a second Gun Trophy in the same discipline.

In such a case, the Gun Trophy shall be awarded to the next highest-ranked eligible athlete in the Final who has not previously received a Gun Trophy in that discipline.

If the next-ranked athlete has also previously received a Gun Trophy in that discipline, the award shall pass to the next eligible athlete in the Final ranking, and so on, until an athlete who has not previously been awarded a Gun Trophy in that discipline is identified.

Prize Voucher Eligibility: An athlete who is awarded a Gun Trophy shall not be eligible to receive any prize voucher. In the event that such an athlete is otherwise entitled to a prize voucher based on his/her Final position or any other applicable ranking, the prize voucher shall be awarded to the next highest-ranked eligible athlete who has not been awarded a Gun Trophy.

m. Application of Rules to Trap and Skeet Events during Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup

All provisions relating to the categories, qualification rounds, Final, Open Category and Gun Trophy shall apply separately and independently to Trap (ISSF) and Skeet (ISSF) events.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Open Category ranking and Gun Trophy shall be determined independently for Trap (ISSF) and Skeet (ISSF), and the restriction that an athlete shall receive not more than one Gun Trophy shall apply separately within each discipline.

n. ENTRY FEE – Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup

Single Entry Fee – Rs. 4950/- plus 18% GST = Rs. 5841/-

Triple Entry Fee – Rs. 4950/- X 3 = Rs. 14850/- + 18% GST = Rs. 17523/-

o. AWARDS – Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup

M/s Beretta, vide their email dated 9th September 2026 has announced various awards for the participants of Beretta 500 Year Anniversary Gold Cup. The copy of the same is attached herewith for ready reference of all.

19. CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- Be respectful towards fellow athletes, officials, coaches, support staff and staff working at the ranges.
- Be punctual and diligent and adhere to the scheduled timings.
- Follow the directions of officials.
- Be appropriately dressed in accordance with the dress code prescribed by ISSF.

- f. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- g. Must not verbally abuse, intimidate or distract, in any form, including by shouting or making gestures, any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach, opposing team official or opposing athlete.
- h. Shall not indulge in any political, religious or other discourse or discussions.
- i. Shall not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal or sexual advance towards anyone.
- j. Shall adhere to the rules prescribed by the Government of India, Sports Authority of India, NRAI or any other agency associated with the Championship.
- k. Shall abide by the ISSF Code of Ethics.
- l. Shall not consume alcohol or tobacco at the range.
- m. It is the responsibility of the athlete to be aware of all applicable rules and to ensure that his/her equipment complies with ISSF regulations.
- n. The athlete is responsible for following all rules and norms and for going through all notices issued by NRAI at the Range and/or on the NRAI website.
- o. Shall adhere to WADA/NADA rules and shall not use any prohibited substances or drugs.
- p. In case of any grievance, the athlete may contact the Director of Competition as per the details given below.
- q. Shall not interact with the media in any form or through any print, electronic or social media platform, or post any material that is contrary to the spirit of the IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow athletes, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI or the policies of the Government of India/SAI/NRAI.
- r. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media reports or statements relating to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches, team officials and/or athletes that are personal in nature, imply bias or question their integrity.
- s. Violation of the above provisions may lead to cancellation of the athlete's entry in the Championship.

20. The NRAI reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the NRAI in any such matter will be final.
