The National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) invites applications for appointment of a qualified and experienced High-Performance Manager (HPM) for its National Squad of shooters in the discipline of Shotgun. The HPM, primarily, will be responsible for monitoring the training and development program of the shooters to achieve excellence in the sport to perform at various international competitions.

QUALIFICATION

- Should have knowledge of shooting sport
- Should be able to communicate in English
- Should be physically fit
- Should be below 65 years of age. However, in exceptional cases, the National Rifle Association of India may take a decision based on the credentials of the coach, if age exceeds 65 years.

EXPERIENCE

- Should have leadership and management skills
- Should have the experience of at least 3 years as HPM/Sports Administrator
- The knowledge of sports science / mental training will be considered as an added eligibility qualification
- Should have experience to evaluate the progress and performance of shooters and supervise execution of the plans by the coaches

SALARY

It is Negotiable and will be settled as at mutually agreed terms. The payment of salary to foreign nationals will be in accordance with laws of India and can repatriate the salary as per Foreign Exchange rules of India.

During the stay in India, free lodging, and transport, as per Sports Authority of India (SAI), Govt. of India norms, will be provided.

TENURE

The tenure of the contract will be from the date of appointment till Olympic Games 2024
