CIRCULAR

TECHNICAL RULES

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1. ORGANISATION

All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD) will be organising the 2nd National Deaf Shooting Championship in accordance with ISSF Rules and NRAI Match Book 2024 (amended).

2. VENUE

The 2nd National Deaf Shooting Championship will be held at Ahmedabad at two different venues from 20th to 23rd March 2025.

- a) 10m events to be held at Sports Authority of Gujarat (SAG) Range at Khokhra, Ahmedabad.
- 25m & 50m events to be held at Ahmedabad Military & Rifle Training Association Ranges at Khanpur, Ahmedabad.

3. SCHEDULE

a) As per Annexure "A"

4. PARTICIPATION

- a) Participation in the Championship is restricted to shooters who must be deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55dB PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard).
- b) Open to Deaf shooters who participated in the 65th,66th ,67th NSCC in any category
- c) Shooters who achieve the NRAI trial MQS scores of Deaf Category, will be eligible to participate in the selection trial for International Deaf Competitions to be held later this year.
- d) A training camp has been proposed to be held during this year, for top 5 ranked shooters of all events of this Championship. This is subject to Sports Authority of India's approval of the camp and the number of shooters to be included.

5. CLASSIFICATION OF AGE GROUP

a) There is no age category. All shooters will participate in a single category.

6. CONDUCT OF EVENTS

- a) Events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules.
- b) 10m Air Rifle & Air Pistol matches will be conducted on Electronic Target System.
- c) 50m & 25m matches will be conducted on paper targets. Shooters are advised to carry spotting scopes for their personal use during their matches.
- d) Shooters will have to shoot matches without hearing aids. Hearing aids will not be allowed in the field of play. Players have to remove hearing aids before entering the field of play prior to start of matches & training.
- e) Finals will be conducted only in events with minimum 08 (eight) participants.

8. SUBMISSION OF ENTRY FORMS

Entries will be accepted through the "NRAI's ONLINE SYSTEM". Shooters are required to visit the website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. Last date for accepting entries is 28th Feb 2025.

9. WEAPON CARRY AUTHORITY LETTER

Shooters travelling by air, can download Weapon Carry Authority Letter from website www.thenrai.org after filling their entries. DGCA letter can be downloaded form

10. PROTEST AND APPEALS

Any protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF Rues and NRAI Match Book 2024. The protest fee is Rs. 200/-(Rupees two hundred only) and should be filed within 30 (thirty) minutes of completion of match and in case of Appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred only) to be filed within 1 (one) hour of completion of match.

11. WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION

Shooters have to bring their own Equipment. No ammunition or Air Pellets will be available for purchase at the venues.

Shooter must carry Equipment control card of last NSCC played.

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- a) Participants are requested to go through above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- b) Scores achieved in this competition will be considered to qualify for group B trials, as per group B trial MQS.
- c) Participants are expected to follow rules of the competition strictly and maintain discipline on and off the field.

- d) Entry fees will not be refunded in case of non-participation after submission of entry.
- e) Shooting Kit (Equipment & Clothing) of competitors should be strictly as per ISSF rules.
- f) Shooting practice in place of Accommodation is strictly prohibited. In case of violation disciplinary action will be initiated and shooter may be barred from taking part in the competition.
- g) Accompanying persons/ personal coaches are not allowed to enter field of play.
- h) The organisers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- i) The organising committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/ circumstances beyond their control. Any decision made by the Organising Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions.
- j) Shooters are advised to carry printout of their competitor card and UDID/ Disability certificate.

13. CODE OF CONDUCT

- a) Be a responsible human being and a committed sportsperson.
- b) Be respectful towards fellow shooters, officials and staff.
- c) Be punctual.
- d) Shall follow directions of the officials.
- e) Shall dress appropriately as per dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f) Shall not indulge in any kind of verbal abuse, or intimidation in form of shouting, making gesture, or any other form of distraction towards any spectator, official, players or coaches.
- g) Shall not indulge in any political or religious discourse /discussions.
- h) Shall not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal or sexual advance towards anyone.
- i) Shall not consume alcohol or tobacco in the competition premises.
- j) It is the responsibility of the shooter to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations
- k) Shooter is responsible for following all rules/ norms and go through the notices issued by AISCD/ NRAI.
- Adhere to WADA/ NADA rules and not use drugs which are not permitted under WADA/NADA.
- m) In case of any grievance contact the director of competitions as per details given below.
- n) Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/ electronic/ social platform or post any material which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF rules, shooting sport, fellow shooters, coaches other office bearers of AISCD or NRAI and against policies of the Government of India.
- Shall not bring shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players that are personal in nature, imply bias or question their integrity.
- p) Violation of the above may lead to cancellation of entry of this championship.
- q) Shooters may contact the Director of Competition for any further information details that maybe required by them and might not have been covered by the above instructions.

14. FOOD & ACCOMMODATION

- a) All the shooters and accompanying Coach-cum-Managers (for the prescribed number only) shall be provided with free boarding & lodging during the Games.
- b) Accommodation will be at Shri. Swaminarayan Temple, Maninagar, Ahmedabad 380 008.
- c) No observer or parents shall be allowed.
- d) All shooters and managers must bring their own bed sheet / blanket and personal items.
- e) The mess will open with the lunch on 20th March 2025 and will close with the Evening Tea on 24th March, 2025.
- f) Teams / Competitors (including accompanying officials) who have lost their match / event and having no more match / item to complete in the Championship can leave the camp, if they desire so, with the permission of the Organising Secretary. List of such competitors must be submitted to the Organising Secretary by the Manager / Head of the concerned State team.

15. PRIZES & AWARDS

- a) Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals and Certificate of Merit will be presented to I, II and III place winners, respectively.
- b) Certificate of Participation will be awarded to all participants by the Hosts.
