SUB: STAGING OF XXXIII ALL INDIA G. V. MAVALANKAR SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP IN PISTOL EVENTS AT SARAGARHI SHOOTING ACADEMY, GURU NANAK COLLEGE, VELACHERY, CHENNAI, TN.

Dear Sir/Madam,

The XXXIII All India G. V. Mavalankar Shooting Championship in Pistol events will be held at **SARAGARHI SHOOTING ACADEMY, GURU NANAK COLLEGE, VELACHERY, CHENNAI, TN from 3rd to 12th November, 2024** as detailed in the program attached. This Championship will be conducted by Tamil Nadu Shooting Association under the aegis of the National Rifle Association of India and as per rules and regulations under NRAI Match Book.

Those competitors, who want to participate in this Championship, are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for their own convenience and to ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above Championship. All the matches will be conducted according to NRAI Match Book. The Match Book is available on our website www.thenrai.in

A shooter is eligible to participate in AIGVMSC only if he/she has achieved the following minimum qualifying scores as per Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book in the previous AIGVMSC, Zonal Championship or State Championship (Full course as per NRAI Match Book), conducted by the State Rifle Association in those events in which he/she wishes to participate. Please refer to rule 1.6 of NRAI Match Book as Annexure "B" as attached. Scores of such competitions must be filled at the time of filing online entry for AIGVMSC. Shooters furnishing wrong information shall be debarred from taking part in any Championship for two years.

Shooters who failed to maintain the Minimum Qualifying Scores as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book during previous NSCC will enter in Matches for MQS only and will not be eligible for any Medal/Ranking. Please see Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match Book.

Shooters, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2024, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches

Juniors – 21 yearsBorn in 2003 or after.Youth - 19 years or beforeBorn in 2005 or afterSub Youth - 16 years or beforeBorn in 2008 or after

Masters -45 - 60 years
Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition
Senior Masters -60 - 70 years
Super Masters -70 years
Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition
Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition

SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP. SIMILARLY, SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 10 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN AIR WEAPON EVENTS. Shooters, who participated in previous NSCC but failed to achieve MQS under 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, must file their entry in MQS category failing which they will be disqualified as per Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match Book.

Shooters, who participated in 65th /66th NSCC and achieved the MQS, as required under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, are not eligible to participate in National Rule matches.

Shooters, who have not received/applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number

The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. THE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED via "NRAI's ONLINE SYSTEM" and no paper entry will be accepted. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.nrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 25rd October, 2024. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 25th October, 2024.

In case any Shooter/Affiliated unit needs any assistance for filing the entry, he/she must approach NRAI immediately BUT before 23rd October, 2024, so that their entries are accepted with normal fee. Shooters contacting for assistance after 23rd October, 2024 are liable to pay triple fee. Shooters may may also send email on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com for any query.

Shooters, who achieved scores as per rule 1.4. of NRAI Match Book are eligible to participate in this Championship. Shooters achieving scores as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book will be allowed to participate in 67thNSCC. The details are attached. Copy of the NRAI Match Book is available on the website of NRAI www.thenrai.in

Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid "online" and no cash/draft will be accepted. Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. Protest fee is Rs. 300/-(plus 18% GST).

In case shooter is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the shooter and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The shooter will be allowed to participate in other events of the NSCC only after payment of penalty amount.

The State Rifle Associations/Units will be imposed a penalty of Rs. 3000/-(Plus 18% GST) per shooter in case their shooters score below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during Zonal Championship under Rule 16.15 of NRAI Match Book. The State/Unit must remit the penalty amount with NRAI immediately otherwise shooters from that unit/state will not be allowed to participate in any competition conducted by NRAI. The Secretary General may also call for explanation of the unit/state for sending such shooters. Shooters participating in AIGVMSC on the basis of their performance during any competition conducted by NRAI shall be exempted.

IMPORTANT

Only three (3) shooters will be allowed to use common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be intimated together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable to work out the details for the conduct of the relevant matches.

ACCOMMODATION

There are vast range of hotels available in Chennai. Shooters are requested to contact hotels directly for their bookings.

AMMUNITION

Ammunition will be issued against payment only on valid arm license of Association/Club/Individual or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity must be obtained from the local licensing authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to NRAI.

FOR PARA SHOOTERS

Shooter who achieves MQS as per Annexure "B" will be eligible to participate in 67th NSCC. Shooters who achieve MQS as per Annexure "B" will be notified as "Renowned Shooter "and they will also be eligible for grant of Import permit for Import of their equipment's. List of NR Matches as per Annexure "B attached.

All Shooters, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category.

FOR DEAF SHOOTERS

There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf shooters may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf shooters.

Participation in Deaf category is restricted to shooters who must be Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 db PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard)

- 1. Shooters wanting to participate in Deaf category for the first time have to email their Disability Certificate/Audiogram from Govt. Hospital to Technical Director/Coach, email ID anujajung@gmail.com or WhatsApp Mobile Number 09868206320, for verification by Coach and AISCD (All India Sport Council of the Deaf)
- 2. Shooters whose disability certificates have been verified earlier do not need to verify again.
- 3. Entry in Deaf category will be accepted online. Email match no. to anujajung@gmail.com verification of documents.
- 4. Deaf shooters can also participate in General category events as per MQS achieved, for the event to participate in. Entry in General Category should be submitted directly on the NRAI's online system.
- 5. Scores achieved by deaf shooters in General category will be considered for MQS in Deaf category. (Copies of Clauses 1.4 and 17.6 are attached herewith at Annexure "C" " for your ready reference. List of matches is at Annexure "D".

AWARD OF MEDALS

The medals will be awarded in individual category as follows:

- 4 shooters 3 Medals
- 3 Shooters 2 Medals
- 2 shooters 1 Medal
- 1 shooter no Medal

Master/Sr. Master and Super Master exempted.

The NRAI/Organizing Committee reserve the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by NRAI/Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.

Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules. Half pants/Jeans and chappals are not permitted on the range.

COVID PROTOCOLS

Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/TamilNadu Govt.
