COMMON GENERAL RULES FOR IPC SHOOTING RULES ALL INDIA G.V. MAVLANKAR SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS, NATIONAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP COMPETITIONS AND ALL OTHER COMPETITIONS RECOGNIZED BY NRAI

1. ELIGIBILITY

1.1.1. Participation is open to competitors belonging to State Associations/Units affiliated to NRAI. In case where no State Association exists, competitors belonging to clubs directly affiliated to NRAI will be allowed to participate. NRAI members must also take part through State Rifle Association/Clubs of their native place otherwise; their entry will not be accepted. All the State Rifle Associations/Units will allow the members of NRAI to participate in the competitions organized by NRAI without becoming a member of that State/Club to which he/she belongs. However, if there is no such Association/Club functioning in their State, they can take part as members of NRAI provided they have paid all their dues towards NRAI.

The affiliated State Rifle Associations/units will forward entry of the member of NRAI subject to the member undertaking to follow all the rules and regulations applicable to the Athletes of that State. The State Rifle Associations/units may also charge an additional fee equal to entry fee of the competition but not more than Rs. 5000/- for forwarding the entries of Life/Annual Members of NRAI. This is applicable when these Athletes are not members of State/Unit or any District/club to which Members of NRAI wish to represent. The Members of NRAI must have achieved MQS as defined for each competition under NRAI Match Book.

- 1.1.2 The National Rifle Association of India shall organize competitions at Zonal/all India level competitions namely Zonal Championships, All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship, All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship (AIGVMSC), National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC), Kumar Surendra Singh Shooting Championship in Big Bore/Small Bore/Shotgun events, Digvijay Singh Memorial Shooting Championship, India Open Competition as per ISSF/IPC/NR/Deaf Rules. The Governing Body may modify the said rules to suit the local conditions.
- 1.1.2.1 The Governing Body of NRAI may grant permission/recognize any competition to be conducted under these rules.

1.1.2.1.1 The level of the competitions is defined as under:

(i) National Level Competition:

- a. National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC) the highest-level competition, the National Championship held once in a year.
- b. Kumar Surendra Singh Shooting Championship All India level Championship.
- c. All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship All India level Championship for school students.
- d. Digvijay Singh Memorial Shooting Championship
- e. Any other Competition, as approved by NRAI.

(ii) Pre-National Competitions:

- a. All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship (AIGVMSC)
- b. India Open Competition
- c. **Zonal Championships:** Zonal Championships organized on a regional basis, grouping of participants from specific geographical zones of India East, West, North, South and Northeast Zone.
- d. Any other Competition, as approved by NRAI.

(iii) State Level Competitions:

- a. All State Championships organized and conducted by affiliated State Rifle Association.
- b. Pre-State Championship
- c. Any other competition organized by State Rifle Association, affiliated to NRAI.
- 1.1.3 The Rules framed under NRAI Match Book shall be applicable to all competitions as stated under Rule 1.1.2 and 1.1.3 above, in Selection Trials or any other competition organized and conducted by NRAI or recognized by the Governing Body of NRAI.
- 1.1.4 Definition of international Athlete/international medalists (senior/junior/youth):
 - a. A person, who has participated in an international competition, where an Indian team selected as per ranking by NRAI and sponsored by NRAI/SAI/Govt./own cost, will be an "international Athlete" in respective category (senior/junior, youth, Masters, Senior Masters, Super Masters, Deaf). This is subject to achieving MQS equal or above the MQS fixed for selection trials, by a Athlete in international competition.
 - b. A person may be an international Athlete in more than one category.
 - c. A person, who has won an individual/Team medal in an international competition, where an Indian team, sponsored by NRAI/SAI/Govt. has participated, will be an international medalist in respective category (senior/junior or youth)
 - d. A person, who has won an individual medal in an international competition, where an Indian team, sponsored by NRAI/SAI/Govt. has participated, will be an international medalist in respective category (senior/junior or youth).
 - e. A person may be an international medalist in more than one category.

- f. Athletes, who have participated at on own cost in competitions other than the competitions as stated at (a) and (c) are not recognized as international Athlete or international medalist.
- g. In Sport of Shooting, there are three recognized sections Rifle, Pistol, and Shotgun. The Rifle section includes Big Bore events also.
- h. The Athlete must have achieved MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book to be considered as International Athlete/Medalist.
- 1.2 Sub Youth/Youth/Junior Athletes can take part in higher category matches subject to achieving MQS as fixed under their age category under Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book.
- 1.3 Foreign Nationals and teams from Foreign Countries, may be permitted to participate in the matches of Competitions. However, they will not be eligible for any Trophies or Medals. Mementoes may be awarded to them. All rules, as stated under this Match Book, shall be applicable to Foreign Nationals
- 1.4 A Athlete is eligible to participate in AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP/or any other competition recognized by NRAI only if he/she has achieved the following minimum qualifying score in the previous AIGVMSC, Zonal Championships, All KSS Inter School Shooting Championship (air weapon events only), Inter University, Inter College Competitions (conducted under the supervision of NRAI), in State Championship (Full course as per NRAI Match Book) conducted by the State or any other competition approved by the Governing Body of NRAI in those events in which he/she wishes to participate. Scores of such competitions must be filled at the time of sending entries for AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/or any such state level competition conducted by the State (where the State announces the competition in their annual calendar and scores appear on the website of the State Association immediately on completion of the competition) or any other competition approved by the Governing Body of NRAI in those events in which he/she wishes to participate. Scores of such competitions must be filled at the time of sending entries for AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/or any other competition recognized by NRAI. Scores of special selection trials, conducted by affiliated units, for the Athletes, who failed to achieve MQS in said competitions, shall not be considered. In case Athlete is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the Athlete. The Athlete will be allowed to participate in the competition only after payment of penalty amount.

1.5 All affiliated State Rifle Associations/Units will conduct their State Championships one month before the start of AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship, whichever is earlier by using NRAI Online portal. In case, there is no State Rifle Association, results of competitions conducted by affiliated clubs by using NRAI Online portal, will be recognized.

- 1.5.1 The State Rifle Associations may conduct Pre-State Competitions with an objective to bolster grassroots participation and skill development among Athletes. The Rules for conduct of these Championships are as under:
 - 1. The periodicity of the Pre-State Championships will be bio-monthly basis.
 - 2. The States hosting Pre-State Championship must publish Relays of competitions on their website (if available) or inform their affiliated Distt. and NRAI.
 - 3. Entries must be accepted through the portal of NRAI and scores of such competitions must be uploaded during the competition. No scores can be uploaded after the close of the competition.
 - 4. Athletes, who participate in Pre-State Championship, will be eligible to participate in India Open Competition.
 - 5. No recommendation for grant of arm license, as Aspiring Athlete, can be made based on performance in Pre-State Championship. Recommendations for grant of arm license can only be made based on performance in State Championship, which is conducted once in a year.
 - 6. The States may award medals, as decided by the State Rifle Association.
 - 7. Entry Fee as per NRAI Match Book.
- 1.6 Any Athlete, who has achieved MQS, as per Rule 1.4 of NRAI in latest State level Championship, can participate in current years' AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship. In case Athlete fails to achieve MQS or did not participate in a State level Championship, then the Athlete may participate based on his/her scores during preceding State level Championship in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship.
- 1.6.1 Any Athlete, who has achieved MQS (NR), as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI in latest AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/INTER SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP, can participate in current years' NSCC. In case Athlete fails to achieve MQS or did not participate in latest AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/INTER SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP, then the Athlete may participate in NSCC based on his/her scores during preceding in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship.
- 1.7 Once a Athlete participated in the NSCC and achieved MQS (ISSF) as per Rule 17.6, then the Athlete is not eligible to participate in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/INTER SCHOOL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP in that particular event. The MQS, if not revised, would be valid for next NSCC. In case Athlete fails to achieve MQS consecutively in two NSCCs, then the Athlete is required to participate under MQS category in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship to achieve required MQS under 17.6 (NR). The Athlete is not required to participate in a State Championship for the purpose of achieving MQS under Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book.
- 1.8 For the purpose of a shooting year, stated under these rules: Beginning from the first day of NSCC to the first day of next NSCC will be one shooting calendar year.

2. BOARDING/LODGING

2.1 It will be the responsibility of the Athletes to make arrangements for their boarding and lodging wherever the Championship is held. However, the host State Association/Unit/Club may help in providing necessary Boarding and Lodging facilities as near to the Range as possible, provided the competitors intimate their requirement to the Organizing Committee well in time.

3. TRAVELING FACILITIES

- 3.1 Railway concession vouchers will be issued by NRAI, which will entitle a competitor to travel from his home Station to the place of competition at concession rate, as may be allowed by the Ministry of Railways from time to time. The necessary particulars in the entry form must be furnished for issue of these concession vouchers.
- 3.2 Team Officials accompanying the team are also eligible for this railway concession vouchers.

4. SHOOTING PRACTICE

4.1 The competitors are allowed practice on the Tournament Ranges as per the directions of the organizers. Competitors are requested not to arrive in the Camp before the due date of arrival as announced by the Organizers.

5. ARMS/AMMUNITION

- 5.1 NRAI/Organizers will provide no arms to the competitors.
- 5.2 The required ammunition for practice and competitions will be provided against cash payment, to the competitors against their valid arms license/special permit subject to the availability of ammunition. The quantity will be decided by NRAI from time to time, according to the availability of stocks.
- 5.3 Imported ammunition will be supplied during National Championship/AIGVMSC for ISSF/IPC and National Rule matches, subject to availability of the same.

6. ENTRY APPLICATION FORM/ENTRY FEE

6.1 Athletes desirous of participating in competitions organized by NRAI and other competitions, which are recognized by NRAI must have Shooter ID. The athlete must apply, through respective State Rifle Association/Units, for Shooter ID "ONLINE system" by visiting NRAI website www.thenrai.in. The Shooter ID will be issued on receipt of approval from the State Rifle Association/Unit. The Shooter ID fee is Rs. 500/- plus GST as applicable from time to time. The registration will be valid for five years from the date of issue of ID Registration and is renewable after five years on a payment of Rs. 500/- plus taxes as applicable. In case of any amendment in registration Relays, the amendment fee is Rs. 500/- plus taxes.

- 6.2 The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only through "ONLINE SYTEM" and no paper entry will be accepted. The Athletes are required to visit NRAI website www.thenrai.in to file their entries along with payment of entry fee "Online". The online entries with normal fee will be accepted as per dates decided by NRAI. Late entries will be accepted with triple entry fee.
- 6.3 The late entry may however be accepted with three times the normal entry fee till 17.00 hours, two days before the inauguration of the Competition provided it does not disturb the schedule of the matches and the same is accepted by the Organizing Committee. In case draw has been made for the match in whom the late entry has been accepted, the Organizing Committee will decide the Relay and lane number from which the competitor will shoot that particular match.
- 6.4 Entry fee is neither refundable nor adjustable or transferable from one match to another or from one Athlete to another.
- 6.5 All matches of similar nature will be fired concurrently but the entry fee shall be paid separately for each event.
- Athletes desirous of representing another state/unit must take a NOC from their parent State/unit. Change of State/Unit is permitted between 1st of **February to 30th of September** every year and after that no Athlete is allowed to change his/her State/Unit except Athlete who wish to change the State on account of joining/retiring from a Govt. job/sponsorship. The NCC cadets joining or leaving the Organization may change their State at the time of joining/leaving the Organization subject to obtaining NOC from the State/DG NCC. No NOC will be accepted, after the date of issue of Circular of the Competition.
- 6.6.1 The Affiliated unit, at the time of issue NOC to a Athlete during February September, must send copy of NOC immediately to NRAI through email for its record. In absence of this, NOC will not be accepted.
- 6.6.2 The change of State fee is fixed as Rs. 1500/- plus GST, as applicable
- 6.7 Athletes furnishing wrong information regarding their previous participation and date of birth shall be debarred from taking in any championship for two years.
- 6.8 In NSCC, matches for men and women in rifle and pistol will be conducted in two categories i.e. National Championship and Civilian Championship. Personnel from Services and Para-military forces, who are in uniform or on pay roll or international medalist as per clause 1.1.5 (c) above are allowed to take part only in matches of National Championship as well as other matches specifically prescribed for them. Paramilitary forces exclude State Police and Home Guards. Athletes furnishing wrong information in this regard will be debarred for one year.

The personnel of Services/Para Military Forces may be permitted to shift to the State of their <u>Domicile only</u> after obtaining NOC from their Organization with the condition that such Athletes will participate only in open category matches, as defined under this Clause. The States Rifle Associations, while accepting requests from such Athletes, can formulate their own conditions on minimum years of representation of their State by such Athletes.

- 6.9 International medalist as per clause 1.1.5 (c) above are not allowed to participate in any Civilian Match of any category.
- 6.10 For the purpose of clarity, the Event, Category and Match are defined as under:
 - i. Events, as recognized by ISSF (like 50M Rifle Prone)
 - ii. Category Age categories, as approved by the Governing Body of NRAI
 - iii. Match Match consists of Event and Category as per (i) and (ii) (Like 50M Rifle Prone Junior Men)

7. TIME SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Matches will normally be held between 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. It is the responsibility of the competitors to be acquainted with the program, timetable, etc. and to be present when their turn comes, failing which their names will be struck off from the matches. No refund of entry fee will be made.
- 7.2 The selection of Relays will be available to athletes on "first come first serve basis". The NRAI would also make a provision where top ranking will be put in last Relays followed by Finals. The detailed rules on the selection of Relays are attached herewith.

8. ORDER OF FIRE 3 POSITION MATCHES

8.1 In all three position matches, the order of fire will be as laid down in ISSF/IPC rules. At present it is, kneeling, prone and standing.

9. SHOOTING

- 9.1 All devices or equipment which may facilitate shooting, and which are not mentioned in these rules and regulations are forbidden.
- 9.2 The Firearms and Equipment Control Jury as well as Range jury shall have the right to examine a Competitors' Firearms, ammunition equipment and apparel. The responsibility shall be upon the competitor to submit questionable equipment and apparel for official inspection and approval in sufficient time prior the beginning of a match so that it is not inconvenient either to the competitor or the officials. Team leaders are held equally responsible to ensure that the competitor has only equipment and apparel, which meets the regulations.
- 9.3 The Equipment Control shall be carried out according to prevailing ISSF/IPC Rule. In case of any violation of these rules, the action, as defined under ISSF/IPC rules shall apply.
- 9.4 If a Athlete alters a weapon or equipment already checked before or during competition in any way that would conflict with ISSF/IPC/National Rules, he will be disqualified.

- 9.5 Open Sight Air Rifle Indian make or foreign make Original "Out of Box" factory made .177/4.5 mm Open Sight Air Gun without any kind of alternation/changes in which air pressure is generated after compressed spring is released when trigger is squeezed. Trigger pressure of such guns must be min 1000 gm. Any original peep sight match gun converted to open sight will not be permitted even if it is spring and piston type in which air pressure is generated after compressed spring is released when trigger is squeezed."
- 9.6 Ties, to decide the first three positions during AIGVMSC/**ZONAL/INDIA OPEN COMPETITON**, will be broken on the last series/count back basis and no "shoot off" will be conducted in the following events:
 - 9.6.1 Centre Fire Pistol
 - 9.6.2 Standard Pistol
 - 9.6.3 Sports Pistol (Men & Women)
 - 9.6.4 Trap (Men & Women)
 - 9.6.5 Double Trap (Men & Women)
 - 9.6.6 Skeet (Men & Women)

10. PRIZES

- 10.1 First three individual aggregate winners will be awarded Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals respectively in ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP/AIGVMSC/National Championship or any other recognized competition.
- 10.1.1 First three individual aggregate winners will be awarded Gold, Silver, and Bronze BADGES respectively in Civilian Championship category matches.
- 10.2 First three teams will be awarded Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals respectively in National Championship category matches.
- 10.2.1 First three team winners will be awarded Gold, Silver, and Bronze BADGES respectively in Civilian Championship category matches.
- 10.3 Medals/Badges will not be awarded to those, whose score is less than the qualifying marks as prescribed for the relevant matches irrespective of their individual position. The grading of those securing above the qualifying marks will be done as usual. This will not apply to the athletes under Deaf, Para, Senior Masters and Super Masters.
- 10.4 The Individual prizes will be awarded as under:
 - a) 3 prizes when there is a minimum of 4 Athletes completed full course.
 - b) 2 prizes when there is a minimum of 3 Athletes completed full course.
 - c) 1 prize when there is a minimum of 2 Athletes completed full course.

The above rule will not apply in case of Deaf, **Para athletes'**, Senior master's and Super Masters categories.

- 10.5 No prize will be awarded in case of a single entry, but organizers may award memento to the Athlete. The said rule will not apply in case of **Deaf**, **Para athletes**, Senior master's and Super Masters categories.
- 10.6 Athletes participating in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship, or any other competition recognized by NRAI to achieve the Minimum Qualifying Scores (MQS) as per rule 17.6.1 below will not be awarded any medal. Any Athlete, who has participated in NSCC but failed to achieve MQS, must participate in MQS category match during AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship. Athletes giving wrong entries in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship will be debarred from taking part in NSCC for one year.
- 10.6.1 Athletes who have achieved MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book in previous NSCC will not be allowed to participate in MQS category during AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP. Athletes giving wrong entries in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship will be debarred for one year from participation in any competition.

11. AGE LIMIT

- 11.1 Age criteria, as per ISSF Rule 3.7.4.12 will be applicable to seniors, junior, youth and sub youth category Athletes.
- 11.2 Persons above the age of 60 years and below the age of 70 years, on the first day of the NSCC/Competition can take part in Senior Masters' category matches subject to achieving scores as per rule 1.4 and 17.6. The Senior Masters' may participate in other categories except sub youth/youth/junior/Super Masters' category.
- 11.2.1 Persons above the age of 45 years and below the age of 60 years (45-60 years), on the first day of the NSCC/Competition, can take part in Masters' category matches subject to achieving scores as per rule 1.4 and 17.6. The Masters' may participate in other categories except sub youth/youth/junior/Senior Masters/Super Masters' categories.
- 11.2.2 Persons above the age of 70 years, on the first day of the NSCC/Competition can take part in Super master's category subject to achieving scores as per rule 1.4 and 17.6. The Super Masters' may participate in other categories except sub youth/youth/junior categories.
- 11.3 For any recognized competition the minimum age for participation in firearms events is 12 and 10 for air gun events. ONLY a competitor who has completed the age of 12 years (for Firearms events)/10 years (for Air Gun events on the first day of the competition including state / zonal / AIGVMSC or any other competition recognized by the NRAI will be permitted to participate in competitions being conducted under NRAI Match Book.
- 11.4 Transit Athletes (junior/youth/sub youth) will be permitted to participate in the next NSCC, if they have achieved the requisite MQS of their present category. This relaxation of rule will apply only for the immediately ensuing NSCC. In the case that such transit Athlete is unable to participate in the ensuing NSCC then s/ he would be required to participate in Zonal Championship/AIGVMSC to achieve MQS required for the present category for participation in subsequent NSCCs.
- 11.5 The above rules are linked to the ISSF rules and any amendment by the ISSF will automatically affect this rule and the new prevailing rule will apply.

12. TARGET

12.1 All targets shall confirm strictly to the ISSF/IPC specifications in every respect unless otherwise stated and shall be provided by the Organizers.

13. RANGE DISCIPLINE

13.1 The Competitors shall observe strict safety regulations and range discipline and shall not load or commence firing unless on the firing line and only when appropriate firing order is given by the Range Officer. The competitors shall carry all weapons with bolts/actions open at all the times except on the firing line. The decision of the appropriate Jury shall be final in all such matters.

14. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

14.1 VERBAL PROTEST

- 14.1.1 Any Athlete or team official has the right to protest a condition of the competition, decision, or action immediately and verbally to a Competition Official, Referee, Range Officer or Jury Member. Such protests may be submitted on the following matters: -
- 14.1.2 A Athlete or team official considers that the ISSF/IPC Regulations, ISSF/IPC Rules, or Competition Program was not followed in conducting the competition.
- 14.1.3 A Athlete or team official does not agree with a decision or action by a competition official, referee range officer or Jury Member.
- 14.1.4 A Athlete was impeded or disturbed by other Athlete(s), competition official(s), and Spectator(s) member(s) of the media or other person(s) of causes(s).
- 14.1.5 A Athlete had a long interruption in shooting caused by equipment failure, the clarification of irregularities or other cause(s).
- 14.1.6 Athletes were delayed by slow target marking or target changing or other unnecessary delay(s).
- 14.1.7 A Athlete had irregularities regarding shooting times, including shooting times that were too short or the non-appearance of targets within the specified time.
- 14.1.8 Competition officials, Referees, Range officers and Jury members must consider verbal protests immediately. They may take immediate action to correct the situation or refer the protest to the full Jury for decision. In such cases, a Range Officer or Jury Member may stop the shooting temporarily if necessary.

14. 2 WRITTEN PROTESTS

- 14.2.1 Any Athlete or Team Official who does not agree with the action or decision taken on a verbal protest may protest in writing to the Jury. Written protest may also be made without making a verbal protest. All written protests must be submitted not later than 30 minutes after the matter in question occurs and must be accompanied by a fee of Rs. 200/-. The protest fee will be returned, if the protest is upheld and will be retained by the Organizing Committee if it is lost.
- 14.2.2 All scoring protests must be submitted within 30 minutes after the official scores are posted on the main score board. The time when the scoring protest time ends must be posted on the main score board. A protest fee of Rs. 200/- per individual result must be paid to the Secretary, NRAI along with the protest. The fee will be returned if the protest is upheld and retained by the Organizing Committee if the protest is lost.
- 14.2.3 Decision by the Classification Jury on value or number of shots on a target is final and may not be appealed.
- 14.2.4 In the event of disagreement with a Jury decision except Rule 14.2.3 the matter may be appealed to the Jury of Appeal in writing by the team leader or a representative within one hour after the Jury decision has been announced, along with a protest fee of Rs. 500/-. The fee along with protest will be returned if the appeal is upheld and will be retained by the Organizing Committee if the appeal is lost.
- 14.2.5 In special circumstances, the time for submitting appeals to the Jury of Appeal may be extended up to 24 hours, by decision of the Jury of Appeal. The decision of the Jury of Appeal is final.

15. ELIGIBILITY OF NCC CADETS/HOME GUARDS/MP's/MLA's

15.1 There is no separate category for Athletes from NCC or Home Guards. Athletes from these organizations can participate in categories for Civilians. The entries of NCC cadets must be forwarded through DG NCC, New Delhi. Athletes from Home Guards may participate through respective States where they are residing.

16. GENERAL

- 16.1 The competitions will be conducted according to ISSF/IPC or National Rules and Regulations as applicable unless otherwise stated.
- 16.2 It is the responsibility of the competitor to be completely familiar, understand the competition rules of ISSF/IPC and NRAI and it is so presumed when he/she signs the competition entry form and shall agree to abide by the said Rules.
- When a Rule refers to right hand Athletes, the reverse of that rule refers to left-handed Athletes.

- 16.4 Unless a rule applies specifically to a Men's or Women's event, it must apply uniformly to both men's and women's events. (It is hereby clarified that ISSF rules shall apply to able body Athletes and IPC rules shall apply Para Athletes respectively.)
- 16.5 The Preparation and sighters time will be as per rules laid down by ISSF/IPC or modified for NR Matches.
- 16.6 If a Athlete arrives late for a competition, he/she will not be allowed extra time, unless his late attendance is due to circumstances beyond his control. In such cases the amount of extra time to be allowed will be decided by Jury and/or Range Officials.
- 16.7 All Athletes and team officials must be familiar with the program.
- 16.8 The participating State Associations/Units/Clubs should officially nominate a Team Manager, who will be responsible for the conduct of his Team members. The Team Manager or his/her authorized representative only will attend the Managers meetings, submit protests, if any, and be sole in charge of day-to-day affairs of the team concerned. The concerned Athletes can lodge scoring protest also.
- 16.9 These rules have been compiled and passed by the Governing Body of NRAI keeping in view of the latest Rules. However slight changes have been made to suit local conditions. These rules are to be read in conjunction with the ISSF/IPC rules, which are the main basis for the conduct of shooting competitions, by NRAI. In case a Para Athlete takes part in ISSF Rule match as able body Athlete, then the ISSF Rules shall apply to him/her.
- 16.10 Modifications to ISSF/IPC Rules, wherever made are always open to change, revision/amendment, as may be considered to suit local conditions from time to time.
- 16.11 Not-with-standing ISSF/IPC Technical & General Rules, NRAI Governing Body/Organizing Committee is empowered to modify/change/amend the rules and program of competition.
- 16.12 Wherever a reference is made to an article(s) in the rules, it refers to the article(s) of the ISSF/IPC rules. In case of any variation in Relays given in ISSF/IPC Rules, the Relays given in these rules will prevail for all purposes.
- 16.13 In AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship, Athletes taking part in Peep Sight Matches are not allowed to take part in Open Sight Matches.
- 16.13.1 Athletes are permitted to participate in any or all Rifle / Pistol / Shot Gun / Big Bore Rifle events, subject of achieving MQS for respective competitions, at the Zonal / AIGVMSC and the Nationals. However, no concession would be made for Relay allotment and overlapping of events. The NRAI would not make any concessions for Athletes who had overlapping matches due to participation in more than one stream / section of shooting. Also, the Athletes who are members of the NSQ or participate in any Open Selection Trial would not be permitted to participate in more than one stream/section (Rifle, Pistol, or Shotgun) in the selection trials or would not be members of the NQS in more than one stream / section.

- 16.14 No Certificate indicating scores, or rank will be issued to Athletes failing to achieve the qualifying scores as per rule for any competition except a confirmation letter indicating his/her participation in that particular competition.
- 16.15 If a shooter fails to achieve a minimum of 85% of the Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) under NRAI Match Book Clause 1.4, in AIGVMSC/ZONAL/INDIA OPEN COMPETITON a penalty of Rs. 3000/- plus GST will be imposed. This penalty shall be collected from the shooter through the State Rifle Association that approved their entry. The affiliated unit is responsible for ensuring the penalty is paid by the shooter. Until the penalty is paid, the shooter will not be permitted to participate in any NRAI-sanctioned competitions. This rule shall apply only once on first participation by a shooter on the basis of score achieved in a State Competition.
- 16.16 A penalty of Rs. 200/- will be charged if a Athlete loses his/her competitor card during the competition and fresh card will only be issued on deposit of penalty.
- 16.17 The athletes participating in shooting competitions should appear like sports persons and no unsporting clothing should be used by the shooters and they should come to the ranges/prize distribution with proper uniform. The following shall not be used by the shooters during shooting competitions:

Chappals and sandals

Jeans (BLUE)

Sleeveless tops/mini skirts

Camouflaged prints/military/khaki uniforms/hunting clothes (Rest of the colors can be used during competitions.

All type of pants and shorts with external pockets like cargo pants and shorts.

- 16.18 No Athlete will be allowed to change clothing on the firing lines. On victory stand, Athlete will appear in sport uniform of his state/unit track suits only.
- 16.19 In shotgun events, the scores as per score board/computerized score sheet, printed from the centralized scoring system of Laporte or any other similar system shall only be valid. The Referees are required to make corrections, if any, on spot, during the round well before print out is taken. No correction is permissible once the printout has been taken.

17. <u>SPECIAL RULES FOR NATIONAL SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP</u> <u>COMPETITIONS</u>

- 17.1 Open Sight Rifles will not be permitted in any Small Bore and Big Bore Rifles ISSF matches.
- 17.2 Equipment Control for Para Athletes will be done according to IPC Rules as specified for Para Athletes.
- 17.3 All the matches will be conducted in National Championship in Senior, Junior, Sub Youth & Youth category. Sub Youth and Youth Category matches will only be conducted in air weapon events only.

- 17.4 Unless otherwise specified, the number of shots per competition target shall be one only.
- 17.5 The Preparation and sighters time will be as per rules laid down by ISSF/IPC.
- 17.6 An Athlete is eligible to compete in NSCC or any competition approved by the Governing Body of NRAI if he/she has scored a minimum of following scores in respective events during the previous NSCC/National Games/AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP/INTER SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP or any other competition approved by the Governing Body of NRAI. Scores of National Games should not be older than two years. The scores of latest KSS Shooting Championship in all events including RFP event, held during the same year of NSCC will also be valid for participation in NSCC.

- 17.6.1 In case a Athlete fails to achieve the qualifying scores as per rule 17.6 above, he/she will be allowed to participate in the next NSCC based on his/her performance during the preceding NSCC. (Explanation: Scores achieved during 47 NSCC will also be valid for 49 NSCC even if a Athlete fails to achieve the scores during 48 NSCC. Athletes participating for the first time in NSCC and fail to achieve the qualifying scores as above will have to go back to AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP to get the qualifying scores)
- 17.6.2 Olympians/international Athlete/medalist as per Clause 1.1.5 above, Athletes who are Olympians / international medalists would be exempted from participation in the prenationals / qualifying matches for participation in the NSCC, in their respective section (Rule 1.1.5 g). International Athletes (as per the definition under Rule 1.1.5 above) or Open National Championship medalist (either in senior, junior or youth category) or individual medalist of National Games will be exempted from participation in the prenational qualifying matches (AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP) in that event. In case an international Athlete, individual medalist of NSCC (open category) or National Games medalist fails to achieve the required MQS in two NSCCs, the Athlete would be required to participate in pre-national qualifying matches (AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP to qualify for NSCC).
 - (i) The Athletes, at the time of filing their entries should attach Certificate issued by NRAI/Organizers of the Competitions.
 - (ii) Athletes furnishing wrong entries would be liable for disciplinary action.

- (iii) An Arjuna Awardee may participate in any match and would be exempted for life from participation in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship or any such equivalent match.
- 17.7 Rapid Fire Pistol Men Entry into NSCC:
 - 1. A Athlete of CFP / Std P / SP jr. M, who has achieved the scores stated below in any one of the events in the previous NSCC may participate in the RFP event at the NSCC.
 - 2. Once a Athlete has shot the RFP event at the NSCC and has achieved the MQS required as per 17.6, he would be eligible to shoot the RFP event in the next NSCC. If he fails to achieve the requisite MQS then he would have to take a break in next NSCC and re-enter for the RFP event as per clause 1 above. Clause 17.6.1 above will not be applicable for participation in Rapid Fire Pistol event.

Centre Fire Pistol Men - 560 Master - 550 Sr. Master 540 Sport Pistol Jr M -555

Standard Pistol Men - 545 M Jr - 535 Master - 535 Sr. Master 525

Participation by Deaf Athletes in the Rapid-Fire Pistol event in previous NSCC in one of the following events:-

Centre Fire Pistol Men - 530 25M Pistol Men -535 Standard Pistol Men - 515

17.7.1 Any Athlete who has achieved the following scores in the Rapid-Fire Stage (dueling) of the Sport Pistol Event at the preceding NSCC and is also eligible to participate in the Open Selection Trials; will be eligible to participate in the selection trials for the RFPW event. These trials will be conducted solely for the selection of the team for the RFP Mixed event at international competitions and no other purpose.

Sports Pistol (W) Rapid fire stage (dueling): Women- 285 Women Jr. – 280

17.7.2 A junior Athlete who qualifies as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book may shoot senior event also. Similarly, a Sub Youth/ Youth Athlete may participate in senior, junior and Youth category subject to achieving MQS in Youth/Sub Youth Category scores as per rule 17.6.

- 17.8 Anybody who had qualified but was not able to take part in the previous NSCCs in ISSF/IPC events, will be allowed to compete in NSCC provided his/her absence is not more than TWO NSCCs. (Clarification: Performance in the last competition in which he/she has participated will only be considered. However, this clause does not apply to Athletes as per rule 17.6.2.
- 17.9 Athletes achieving scores as per rule 17.6 during NSCC are not eligible to take part in the next AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship in that particular event.
- 17.10 If a Athlete is not qualified for a specific event and attempts to register for it on the NRAI portal, he/she will incur a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST as applicable). Participation in the event will be denied to the Athlete, and Shooter ID of the Athlete will only be reactivated for other events upon payment of the penalty.
- 17.11 Athletes will be eligible for award of medals only if their scores equal or exceed as per rule 17.6.
- 17.11.1 Athletes achieving MQS in ISSF matches, as per Table under 17.6 above, during the NSCC will be notified as Renowned Shot/Renowned Athlete.
- 17.12 Renowned Athletes in small bore rifle events, having MQS as per rule 17.6 above, will be eligible to shoot ISSF Big Bore events during NSCC without participating in AIGVMSC (Big Bore events). Conditions as stated above under 17.6 shall apply.
- a. Participation in 50M Pistol Women/Junior Women in NSCC: Athletes who are Renowned Athlete in both 25M Sports Pistol and 10M Pistol events will be allowed to participate in NSCC without participation in AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP OR INDIA OPEN COMPETITION. In case shooter fails to achieve the required MQS under 17.6 (ISSF) in 50M Pistol event during NSCC, the shooter would be required to participate in pre-national qualifying matches (AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP or INDIA OPEN COMPETITION to qualify for next NSCC).
 - b. 25M Standard Pistol Jr Women: The Junior women Athletes may participate in 25M Standard Pistol Junior events if they are Renowned Athlete 25M Sports Pistol events. In case shooter fails to achieve the required MQS under 17.6 (ISSF) in 25M Standard Pistol Junior Women event during NSCC, the shooter would be required to participate in pre-national qualifying matches (AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP or INDIA OPEN COMPETITION to qualify for next NSCC).
 - c. All other Athletes, who wish to participate in above events, must achieve MQS as per Rule 1.4 and 17.6 of NRAI Match Book during State/AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP/INDIA OPEN COMPETITION for participation in NSCC.

18. TEAM REPRESENTATION

- 18.1 Team events will be conducted only in respect of matches against whom a specific remark to that effect is made.
- 18.1.1 Team medals/Badges may be awarded as under:

- a. 3 Prizes when there is a minimum of 4 teams.
- b. 2 Prizes when there is a minimum of 3 teams.
- c. 1 Prize when there is a minimum of 2 teams.
- d. No prize where there is only 1 team.
- 18.1.2 All affiliated State Rifle Associations/units must send team entry fee also for matches in which they intend to field a team along with the entry form under rule 6.1.
- 18.2 A team shall consist of three Athletes and one reserve, if necessary. All Athletes representing a team should enter in the respective individual events also.
- 18.3 If after the final entry any of the three Athletes of a team withdraws from the team for any reason whatsoever after the commencement of the match the entire team will be scratched.
- Athletes of the same State/Units can form teams only. In case where no State Association exists members of different clubs in the State directly affiliated to NRAI may join and form team. Members of NRAI can also form a team, when, not representing their State, Association/directly affiliated Clubs.
- 18.5 The Athletes can represent their respective States only. Once they have represented the State Rifle Association, they will not be allowed to represent as a member of NRAI in any other match and vice-versa.
- 18.6 No competitor shall represent as a reserve of different teams in any one event.
- 18.7 Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 17.00 hrs. on the previous day of the start of that particular match.
- 18.8 Only one team from each state/unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants in that event.
- 18.9 In Civilian category matches, each state/unit is allowed to enter a maximum of two teams in each event irrespective of the number of participants in that event.
- 18.10 Athletes participating on wild card entry are not allowed to be a member of the team in Open or Civilian Category matches. This will not apply to Athletes participating in Big Bore matches on Wild Cards.

18.11 MIX TEAM EVENTS:

The Following are rules for participation in Mixed Event matches:

- 1. All matches will be shot as per ISSF Rules
- 2. Each team will consist of two Athletes.
- 3. Each team mandatorily will consist of one male and one female Athlete.
- 4. Each Affiliated State/Unit can field only one team.
- 5. No Athlete can be a member of more than one team in the same age category.

- 6. Athletes can represent their State/Unit only and teams cannot be formed having Athletes from two different State/units.
- 7. Athletes participating in Mixed Events must have MQS as prescribed in Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book.
- 8. There will not be any individual event/medal.
- 9. Team medals will be awarded as per Rule 10.2 of NRAI Match Book.
- 10. It is strongly advised that the athletes from each State/Unit wear the State Uniform.

19. EQUIPMENT AND AMMUNITION

19.1. Athletes shall use only equipment and apparel, which comply with ISSF/IPC Rules. Anything (rifles, devices, equipment, accessories etc.) which may give a Athlete an advantage over others, and which is not mentioned in these Rules, or which is contrary to the spirit of the ISSF/IPC regulations and rules, is prohibited. The Athlete is responsible for submitting all equipment and apparel for official inspection and approval to the equipment control prior to the beginning of a competition. Team leaders are held equally responsible for the Athletes to have equipment and apparel, which meet the ISSF/IPC regulations and rules. The Jury has the right to examine a Athlete's equipment and apparel at any time.

20. MEDICAL CLASSIFICATION

Participation in para category by the Para Athletes: Participation will be under the rules and regulations of IPC and on submission of medical certificate. The medical categorization will be done by PCI. Based on submission of medical certificate, as confirmed by PCI, Athletes will be allowed to participate in para category matches.

21. IMPORT OF ARMS/AMMUNITION

21.1 Athletes who fail to achieve the minimum qualifying scores as state under 17.6 above will not be allowed to import any arms/ammunition.

22. MALFUNCTIONS

In ISSF matches, the number of malfunctions shall be in accordance with ISSF Rules.

For NR matches, the following rules shall be applicable:

All events except Centre Fire Pistol and Standard Pistol (NR) – One AMF Centre Fire Pistol – One AMF each in Precision and Dueling Stage Standard Pistol – One AMF in 150 second series and one AMF in 20 and 10 seconds (combined) series

22. MATCHES FOR DEAF ATHLETES

Deaf Athletes, on submission of medical certificate, approved by All India Sports Council for Deaf (AISCD) will be allowed to shoot in matches for Deaf as well as in matches for able body Athletes.



ZONAL COMPETITIONS

The Governing Body in its meeting held on 8th August 2006 has approved rules for the conduct of Zonal Competitions. These rules have been further amended on the recommendations of the Technical Committee by Governing Body of NRAI in its meeting held on 2nd July 2015.

The Rules have further amended by the Governing Body of NRAI in its meeting held on 29th September 2018.

- 1. The Zonal Competitions should be conducted every year and States under the respective zone must conduct this competition by rotation. The following are the guidelines for conduct of Zonal Competitions:
- Athletes, who achieve MQS as per Rule 1.4 will only be permitted to participate in NR matches during Zonal Championships.
- The scores achieved by the Athletes will be considered for participation in AIGVMSC/NSCC.
- Minimum 3 States must take part in the Zonal Championship.
- The format of the competition must be as per the program of All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship.
- Athletes must take part in their respective Zonal Competitions only. Athletes from outside zone are not permitted to participate and their scores will not be considered for any purpose.
- The states are grouped into four zones as under:
 - a. **East Zone:** Bihar, West Bengal, Orissa, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh including Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar
 - b. **Northeast Zone:** Assam, Arunachal, Manipur, Nagaland, Meghalaya, Tripura and Mizoram
 - c. **North Zone:** J & K, Punjab, Haryana, Chandigarh, Delhi, U P, Rajasthan, Uttaranchal & Himachal Pradesh
 - d. **West Zone:** Maharashtra, Gujarat, Goa, Madhya Pradesh, and Union Territory of Daman & Diu.
 - e. **South Zone:** Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, and Union Territory of Pondicherry. Telangana
 - f. The Services/Para-Military Organizations or other Boards may participate in the respective Zones according to their locations.
- 2. Scores achieved by the Athletes during Inter University and Inter College Competitions conducted under the supervision of NRAI will be considered under rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book.

Rules for "Online Selection of Relays for Trials/Competitions (Rifle/Pistol) under Rule 7 of NRAI Match Book

A. Purpose

The purpose of introducing the "Online Relay Allocation system" by the National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) is to enable athletes to plan their participation in shooting competitions and trials well in advance. This system empowers athletes to select their preferred Relay based on personal convenience, thereby promoting better preparedness and time management.

In case of an emergency or any genuine requirement, a athlete may interchange their allocated Relay with another athlete of the same State in the same Group.

Furthermore, these rules facilitate more streamlined administration, allowing both NRAI and the RTS Office to concentrate more effectively on the smooth and efficient conduct of competitions.

B. Definition

- 1. Competition Name of the Competition/Selection Trial
- 2. Event As defined by ISSF e.g. 50M Rifle 3P
- 3. Group Group of athletes of various categories like, Senior, Junior and Youth etc. in an Event.
- 4. Relay The number of Relays will be generated, depending on number of firing lanes available at a range and number of athletes participating from various Units in a particular Group. The number of athletes in a Relay from each participating State, will be decided as per ISSF rules, through an "computerised auto generated system". This will be done based on the total number of athletes from a State.
- 5. Stipulated Dates which may be notified by NRAI for selection/allocation of Relays.

C. Rules

- 1. Athletes can select Relays of their choice, without any fee, "on first come first serve basis" within the stipulated date, as notified on the website of NRAI. These dates will be announced after the last date of entries with late fee and preparation of Relays. (after around 5-6 days of the last date of entries).
- 2. During the "stipulated dates", the athletes will be allowed to select Relays, free of charge, as stated under Rule 1 above.
- 3. The facility of "on first come first serve" basis will close two days prior to start of Competition.
- 4. After the "stipulated date", the NRAI will allocate the vacant slots to athletes who failed to select their Relays through "auto generated system". This will be done two days prior to start of the competition.
- 5. Athletes may interchange the Relays with the athletes of same State and in same Group of an event.

- 6. No fee will be charged from a athlete selecting the Relay for the first time but athlete will be liable to pay fee for all subsequent "interchanges" including during "stipulated dates". The athletes, who failed to select the Relays, as stated under Rule 2, will be liable to pay fee for all "interchanges".
- 7. Top 50 athletes, as per prevailing ranking, will be allocated Relays by NRAI before opening the "online system", as stated under Rule 1 above. In case any such top ranking athlete wishes to interchange the Relays, the athlete must contact NRAI within the "stipulated dates" and athlete will be allowed to interchange the Relay with another athlete of the same State. The athlete would be liable to pay fee, as stated under Rule 8 and 10, if request is received after "stipulated dates".
- 8. Athletes, who have already selected their Relays, as per Rule 1 or have been allocated Relays, as stated under Rule 4 above, wish to inter change Relays, will be allowed to interchange the Relays on a payment fee by the athletes Total Rs. 1180/-.
- 9. This facility will be available till one day before start of the Competition.
- 10. From day one of the competition to one day prior to start of the Event, athlete may interchange their Relays with the athletes of the same state on payment of Rs. 3540/-. After this, no one is allowed to interchange the Relays and "online system" will be closed.
- 11. No permission shall be granted to a single athlete for change of Relay, if no other athlete of the same state is agreeable to interchange. No additional lanes will be added in any Relay for such cases.
- 12. No change of Relays by the athletes of two different states is permitted.
- 13. Any athlete, who fails to report for the selected/allotted Relay and is marked as "Did Not Shoot" (DNS) by the range officials, will not be allowed to shoot in another Relay.
- 14. The lane numbers in each Relay will be drawn by RTS office at the venue by "draw of lots" and same would be notified by the Range officials at the range.
- 15. The above rules will be applicable in all competitions/trials conducted by NRAI.
- 16. No permission for interchange of Relays shall be permitted on the basis of appearing for exams or interviews for any assignment, once the Competition has started.
- 17. Requests received on email or any other mode of communication will not be entertained nor NRAI shall be responding to such requests.
- 18. Since athletes have the liberty to select Relays of their choice, no requests for weapon sharing or clash of events will be entertained.
- 19. The affiliated State Rifle Associations may adopt above rules during their State Championship/competitions.
- 20. The NRAI may consider any request in rare of rarest case. The decision of the NRAI will be final.
