GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZERS

The 0755 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION in (Rifle/Pistol) NR events at MP State Shooting Academy, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh is organized and conducted by the National Rifle Association of India

2. NAME OF THE COMPETITION

0755 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION (OCTOBER 2026) IN RIFLE & PISTOL NR EVENTS

3. VENUE

MP STATE SHOOTING ACADEMY BHOPAL, MADHYA PRADESH.

4. COMPETITION DATES

FROM 5TH TO 22TH OCTOBER 2026

5. LEVEL OF COMPETITION

The Level of the Competition is Pre-National Level Competition as defined under NRAI Match book.

6. CONDUCT OF COMPETITION

Participation will be as per Rules & Regulations of NRAI and ISSF.

7. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Eligibility for Participate in India Open Competition

- a. Athletes who have participated in Pre-State Championship/State Championship/AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship/India Open Competition or in NSCC and failed to achieve MQS are eligible to participate in NR Matches during this Competition. In case any State Rifle Association/Unit did not conduct the Pre-State Championship, the NRAI reserves the right to allow athletes of that State to participate in India Open Competition.
- b. Athletes achieving MQS (NR) under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, as per Annexure “A” during one of the India Open Competitions will be eligible to participate in 69th NSCC. Athletes may participate in multiple India Open Competitions to achieve MQS for participation in 69th NSCC. Athlete having one MQS in one of the India Open Competitions, as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book (NR), will be eligible to participate in 69th NSCC even if he/she fails to achieve MQS in subsequent competitions including AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMMPIONSHIPS.

- c) Athletes are not eligible to participate in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championship, based on the performance during the India Open Competition (IOC).
- d) A penalty of Rs. 3000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/- or as applicable) per event will be imposed on athlete in case athlete's score is below 85% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during the Competition. The State/Unit must recover this amount from the athletes. The State Rifle Association will be responsible for recovery of penalty and deposit the same with NRAI. Athletes will not be permitted to participate in any competition till the penalty amount is paid to NRAI.
- e) In case athlete is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.5900/-) shall be imposed on the athlete and the athlete will not be allowed to participate in that event. The athlete will be allowed to participate in other events only after payment of penalty amount.

8. REPRESENTATION AND ENTRY

The representation and entry for participation in **0755 INDIA OPEN COMPETITION** is as per Rule 6 of NRAI Match Book. The athlete would represent the State as per their registration on NRAI's "Online system". Entries will be accepted on NRAI portal www.thenrai.org The last dates for accepting entries are as under:

With normal fee	–	25th September, 2026 till 7.30 pm
With triple fee	–	26th September, 2026 till 7.30 pm

ALLOCATION OF DETAILS: Athletes are required to select their details, as per their choice and convenience in NR category through NRAI portal www.thenrai.org. The details will be posted on the website of NRAI www.thenrai.in. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. **NO REPLIES SHALL BE SENT TO NRAI FOR CHANGE OF DETAILS**

9. AGE CRITERIA & CATEGORIES

The age eligibility for all age category events shall be determined as on 31st December of the year in which the competition commences and shall remain unchanged for the entire duration of the competition. (age criteria as per ISSF Rule 3.7.4.12)

Athletes, who are completing the age, as stated 31st December of the year in which the competition commence will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Sub Youth - 16 years or before	Born in 2010 or after
Youth - 19 years or before	Born in year 2007 or after
Juniors – 21 years	Born in year 2005 or after
Seniors	Born in year 2004 or before
Masters – 45 to 59 years	Born between year 1967 to 1981
Senior Masters – 60 to 69 years	Born between year 1957 to 1966
Super Masters – 70 years	Born in year 1956 or before

Juniors may participate in Senior Category. Similarly, the Super Masters may participate in all age category matches except junior category. Senior Masters may participate in Masters and Seniors category. Masters can participate in Senior category. Participation in various categories is with the payment of additional entry fee as per rules.

For Deaf Athletes – There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf athletes may participate in other category matches according to their age and in accordance with MQS achieved as per Annexure "B"

For Para Athletes - All athletes, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category.

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP. SIMILARLY, ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 10 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN AIR WEAPON EVENTS.

The ties will be broken as per ISSF/NRAI Match Book rules. No Finals will be conducted in India Open Competition.

The Air Rifle and 50M Prone Events will be conducted in DECIMAL SCORING.

Athlete who achieves MQS, in this Competition, as prescribed under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, will be eligible to participate in the 69th NSCC.

11. AWARD OF MEDALS

- a) Gold, Silver and Bronze Medal will be awarded in each category in individual events.
- b) **Individual medals will be awarded on the basis of Qualification Scores in all categories.**
- c). Rule 10.3 of NRAI Match Book will apply for award of medals.

12. ENTRY FEE

For Air Matches – Rs. 950/- per match plus 18% GST = Rs.1121/-
For Firearms Matches - Rs.675/- per match plus 18% GST = Rs.797/-

13. AMMUNITION

Ammunition will be issued against valid arm license of Association/Club/Individual or special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization or jurisdiction of arm license, special permits for the required quantity and area jurisdiction must be obtained from the local licensing authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds must be returned to NRAI.

No arms will be provided by NRAI/Organizers.

14. SCHEDULE

15. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/-(plus 18%) Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/-(plus 18% GST) Rs.590/-

16. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels for all budgets are available in Bhopal.

17. CONDUCT OF WALTHER CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS - INDIA OPEN COMPETITION 2026

The NRAI will conduct Walther Champion of Champions during this edition. The following are the norms for conduct of Walther Champion of Champions event. The detailed norms were notified in earlier circulars of India Open Competition. The Walther COC shall be conducted in Air Rifle and Air Pistol events.

Qualification Criteria

- The athlete must have participated in any of the India Open Competitions conducted during the calendar year 2026.
- Athlete shall be considered based on his/her one highest qualifying score across all eligible India Open Competitions. Ranking shall be prepared on the basis of scores achieved in one of the following editions of IOC:
 1. IOC at Bhopal – 11th to 17th March, 2026
 2. IOC at Dehradun – 15th to 23rd May, 2026
 3. IOC at Dehradun (Jaspal Rana Memorial) – 13th to 30th July, 2026
 4. IOC at Asansol – 18th to 27th September, 2026
 5. IOC at Bhopal – 5th to 22nd October, 2026

Current NRAI Ranking is subject to change after 0341 IOC at Asanol and 0755 IOC at Bhopal Competition based on the results/performance.

Selection for Walther Champion of Champions Final

- Top **8 athletes** in each event (Air Rifle & Air Pistol) shall qualify. There will not separate category and 8 athletes from all categories with high scores as per ranking shall be selected to participate in WALTHER COC.
- Qualification shall be based on the highest individual score achieved during IOC in 2026.
- All 8 qualified athletes, irrespective of gender, shall compete together in a single Walther Champion of Champions Final.
- The Final shall determine the Walther Champion of Champions for that event.

Awards & Incentives

- a) The winner of the Walther Champion of Champions Final in each event shall be awarded **one Walther Air Weapon**, recognizing outstanding performance and excellence.
- b) An additional **Walther Air Weapon** shall be awarded to the **State/Unit represented by the athlete**, acknowledging both individual merit and institutional support.
- c) The model /type of Walther Air Weapon are as under:-

Walther .177 Air Pistol model LP500

Walther .177 Air Rifle model LG400

General

- a) All matters not specifically covered under these norms shall be governed by the Rules and Regulations of NRAI and ISSF, as applicable.
- b) The decision of NRAI regarding interpretation or implementation of these norms shall be final and binding

18. CODE OF CONDUCT

NRAI Code of Conduct shall be applicable to all participants, Coaches, Technical Officials, and all others connected with the conduct of India Open Competition

- a. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- b. Be respectful towards fellow athletes, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of working at ranges
- c. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- d. Follow directions by officials.
- e. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- g. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- h. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
- i. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- j. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- k. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- l. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
- m. It's the responsibility of the athlete to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- n. Athlete is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
- o. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
- p. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.
- q. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow athletes, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
- r. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- s. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.

19. GENERAL

- a. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance: All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- b. A sum of Rs. 236/- (Rs.200/- plus 18% GST) will be charged in case duplicate Competitor card is issued by NRAI.
- c. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries, entry fee will not be refunded.
- d. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- e. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- f. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- g. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final.

- h. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- i. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The details of squads will be notified on the website of NRAI. Athletes are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.
