GENERAL REGULATIONS

1. ORGANIZERS

The National Rifle Association of India shall be organizing and conducting the 68th NSCC (Shotgun Events) in accordance with the rules of ISSF, NRAI Match Book, formats and groupings as stated below. These rules are available on the websites of ISSF and NRAI.

2. VENUE

The 68th National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC) in shotgun events will be held at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi.

3. COMPETITION DATES (FROM 1ST DECEMBER, 2025 TO 5TH JANUARY, 2026)

- **Trap Events for Group 5: 01 to 04 December, 2025**

- Skeet Events for Group 4: 05 to 07 December, 2025
- Skeet Events for Group 3: 08 to 10 December, 2025
- Skeet Events for Group 2: 11 to 13 December, 2025
- Skeet Events for Group 1: 14 to 16 December, 2025
- Skeet Mix Team Events: 17 December, 2025

- Trap Events for Group 4: 18 to 21 December, 2025
- Trap Events for Group 3: 22 to 25 December, 2025
- Trap Events for Group 2: 26 to 29 December, 2025
- Trap Events for Group 1: 30 December, 2025 to 02 January, 2026
- Trap Mix Team Events: 03 January, 2026
- Double Trap Events: 04 to 05 January, 2026

4. COMPETITION FORMAT & STRUCTURE

• To streamline the conduct of the 68th National Shooting Championship Competitions (NSCC), the events have been divided into the following groups:

- 5 Groups for Trap
- 4 Groups for Skeet

- In the Double Trap event, participants will shoot a total of 120 targets for Men/Women across all categories.
- There will be no Final in the Double Trap event.
- All athletes are required to strictly adhere to their designated shooting days based on their assigned Group (Group 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5).



- Regardless of the category or categories under which they have registered, each athlete is permitted to shoot only once throughout the competition.
- Super Masters entered in Senior Masters and/or other categories shall compete only in their designated Super Masters Group; however, their scores will also be counted towards any other category they have entered in.
- Masters entered in the Men/Women categories shall compete only in their designated Masters Group; however, their scores will also be counted towards any other category they have entered in.
- Juniors entered in the Men/Women categories shall compete in the event Group assigned to them on the basis of their category or score only; however, their scores will also be counted towards any other category they have entered in.
- Youth entered in the Junior/Men/Women categories shall compete in the event Group assigned to them on the basis of their category or score only; however, their scores will also be counted towards any other category they have entered in.
- The Finals for all categories, except Super Masters and Youth, shall be conducted on the day of completion of the respective category's qualification rounds in both Skeet and Trap.
- There will be no Finals for the Super Masters category in any event.
- There will be no Finals for the Youth category in any event.
- Upon completion of Group 2 qualification matches, a consolidated ranking list for Women/Junior Women will be compiled, and the top six (6) athletes in each category will qualify for the Finals, regardless of the Group they participated in.
- Upon completion of Group 1 qualification matches, a consolidated ranking list for Men/Junior Men will be compiled, and the top six (6) athletes in each category will qualify for the Finals, regardless of the Group they participated in.
- Under no circumstances shall athletes participating in any category be permitted to compete in subsequent Groups once the Finals of their respective category have been completed.

Team event rankings will be determined solely by qualification scores, with no separate matches for team events

To be recognized as a renowned shot, athletes must achieve the Minimum Qualifying Scores (MQS) per Rule 17.6 of the NRAI Match Book.

5. SKEET GROUPINGS

- **SKEET GROUP 4 (05 to 07 December, 2025) Men / Women / Junior Men / Junior Women:**
 - Participating in the 68th NSCC for the first time on the basis of achieving MQS in India Open Competitions / Zonal Competitions / AIGVMC held in 2025.
- **Youth Men/ Youth Women):**
 - Participating in the 68th NSCC for the first time on the basis of achieving MQS in India Open Competitions / Zonal Competitions / AIGVMC held in 2025.
 - Those who failed to achieve MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at India Open Competitions / Zonal Competitions / AIGVMC held in 2025.
 - Those who have qualified to participate based on MQS achieved at the 66th or 66th/67th NSCC.



● **SKEET GROUP 3 (08 to 10 December, 2025) Men:**

- Failed to achieve MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but qualified for the 68th NSCC on the basis of MQS achieved at India Open / Zonal / AIGVMC 2025, and shot a score up to and including 85 at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Junior Men:**

- Failed to achieve MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but qualified for the 68th NSCC on the basis of MQS achieved at India Open / Zonal / AIGVMC 2025, and shot a score up to and including 85 at the 66th/67th NSCC.
- Achieved MQS at the 66th/67th NSCC and shot a score up to and including 85 at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Super Master Men/Super Master Women:**

- Participating at the NSCC for the first time or qualified for the 68th NSCC on the basis of MQS achieved at India Open / Zonal / AIGVMC 2025
- Achieved MQS at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Senior Master Men/Senior Master Women:**

- Participating at the NSCC for the first time or qualified for the 68th NSCC on the basis of MQS achieved at India Open / Zonal / AIGVMC 2025
- Achieved MQS at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Master Men:**

- Participating at the NSCC for the first time or qualified for the 68th NSCC on the basis of MQS achieved at India Open / Zonal / AIGVMC 2025
- Achieved MQS at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Finals: Senior Masters and Masters.**

● **SKEET GROUP 2 (11 to 13 December, 2025) Women/Junior Women/Master Women:**

- Qualified based on MQS achieved at the 66th/67th NSCC, irrespective of scores.
- Failed to achieve MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but qualified for the 68th NSCC via MQS at India Open / Zonal / AIGVMC 2025.

○ **Junior Men:**

- Participated in the 66th/67th NSCC and shot between and including 86–99 at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Men:**

Qualified to participate based on the MQS achieved at the 66th/67th NSCC, and those who did not attain MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC by achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions, Zonal Competitions, or AIGVMC held in the year 2025, and had scored between **86 and 99** (both inclusive) at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **Finals: Women and Junior Women**

● **SKEET GROUP 1 (14 to 16 December, 2025) Men:**

- Participated in the 66th/67th NSCC and shot 100 or above.

○ **Junior Men:**

- Participated in the 66th/67th NSCC and shot 100 or above.

○ **Finals: Men and Junior Men**

SKEET MIXED TEAM EVENT SENIORS/ JUNIORS (17 December, 2025)

6. CLARIFICATIONS FOR SKEET GROUPS

Youth Category:

- Irrespective of scores and additional participation in Men / Women / Junior Men / Junior Women categories at the 68th NSCC, all Youth athletes will participate only in Group 4.



○ **Super Master Category:**

- Irrespective of scores and additional participation in Senior Master / Master / Men / Women categories, all Super Masters will participate only in Group 3.

○ **Senior Master Category:**

- Irrespective of scores and additional participation in Master / Men / Women categories, all Senior Masters will participate only in Group 3.

○ **Master Category:**

- Irrespective of scores and additional participation in Men / Women categories, all Masters will participate only in Group 3.

○ **Women / Junior Women:**

- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors in these categories who have participated in the 66th/67th NSCC shall compete only in Group 2
- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors participating in the NSCC for the first time in these categories shall compete in Group 4 only.

○ **Women Masters Category:**

- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors in this category who have participated in the 66th/67th NSCC shall compete only in Group 2
- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors participating in the NSCC for the first time in this category shall compete in Group 2 only.

- **Participating at the NSCC for the first time** on the basis of achieving MQS in India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025.

- Participating at the NSCC for the first time on the basis of achieving MQS in India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025.
- Who failed to achieve MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025.
- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **PARA ATHLETES:**

- Irrespective of whether they are participating on the basis of their score at the 66th/67th NSCC or are first time participants

○ **FOREIGN NATIONALS:**

- Irrespective of whether they are participating on the basis of their score at the 66th or 66th/67th NSCC or are first time participants

● **TRAP GROUP 4 (18 to 21 December, 2025)**

○ **YOUTH MEN/YOUTH WOMEN:**

- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC or have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025.



○ **MEN:**

- Who failed to achieve MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025 and shot a score up to and including 90 at the 66th/67th NSCC

○ **SENIOR MASTERS (MEN & WOMEN):**

- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC or have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025.

○ **FINALS FOR SENIOR MASTERS**

● **TRAP GROUP 3 (22 to 25 December, 2025)**

○ **JUNIOR MEN**

- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC or have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025 and shot a score including and below 85 at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **MEN**

- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC or have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025 **and shot a score between and including 91 to 95 at the 66th/67th NSCC.**

○ **MASTERS (MEN)**

- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC or have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025.

○ **FINALS FOR MASTERS MEN**

● **TRAP GROUP 2 (26th to 29th December, 2025)**

○ **WOMEN/JR WOMEN/MASTER WOMEN**

- Who have qualified to participate, based on the MQS achieved by them at the 66th/67th NSCC and those who failed to attain MQS in the 66th/67th NSCC but have qualified to participate in the 68th NSCC on the basis of achieving MQS at the India Open Competitions/ Zonal Competitions/ AIGVMC held in the year 2025 **irrespective of the score shot at the 66th/67th NSCC**

○ **JUNIOR MEN**

- Who have participated in the 66th/67th NSCC, and shot a score including and above 86 at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **FINALS FOR WOMEN, JR. WOMEN & JR. MEN**

● **TRAP GROUP 1 (30 December, 2025 to 02 January, 2026)**

○ **MEN**

- Who have participated in the 66th/67th NSCC, and shot a score including and above 96 at the 66th/67th NSCC.

○ **FINALS FOR MEN**

● **TRAP MIXED TEAM EVENT SENIORS/ JUNIORS (3rd January, 2026)**

8. CLARIFICATION FOR TRAP GROUPS



○ **Super Master category:**

- Irrespective of their scores and additional participation in Sr Master/Master/Men/Women category at the 68th NSCC, all athletes participating in the Super Master category will participate ONLY in Group 5

○ **Senior Master category:**

- Irrespective of their scores and additional participation in Master/Men/Women category at the 68th NSCC, all athletes participating in the Senior Master category will participate ONLY in Group 4

○ **Youth category:**

- Irrespective of their scores and additional participation in Men/Women/ Jr Men/ Jr Women categories at the 68th NSCC, all athletes participating in the Youth category will participate ONLY in Group 4

○ **Master Men category:**

- Irrespective of their scores and additional participation in the Men category at the 68th NSCC, all athletes participating in the Master category will participate ONLY in Group 3.

○ **Junior Men category:**

- Irrespective of their additional participation in the Men's category at the 68th NSCC, all athletes competing in the Junior Men's category shall participate only in Groups 2 and 3, in accordance with the prescribed scores for Junior Men in these groups
- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors of this category participating in the NSCC for the first time in this category shall compete in Group 5.

○ **Women / Junior Women Category:**

- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors in these categories who have participated in the 66th/67th NSCC and achieved MQS shall compete only in Group 2
- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors participating in the NSCC for the first time in these categories shall compete in Group 5 only.

○ **Women Masters Category:**

- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors in these categories who have participated in the 66th/67th NSCC shall compete only in Group 2
- Irrespective of any additional participation at the 68th NSCC, all competitors participating in the NSCC for the first time in these categories shall compete in Group 2 only.

9. SCHEDULE

10. PARTICIPATION

a. Participation is open to competitors from State Rifle Associations/ Units affiliated to NRAI. In case where no State Rifle Association exists, competitors belonging to clubs directly affiliated to NRAI will be allowed to participate. NRAI members must take part through State Rifle Associations/ Units of their native place otherwise their entry will not be accepted. However, if there is no such Association / Club functioning in their State, they can take part as members of NRAI provided they have paid all their dues towards NRAI.

b. State Rifle Associations/Units will allow the members of NRAI to participate in the competitions organized by NRAI without becoming a member of that State/Club to which he/she belongs subject to the member undertaking to follow all the rules and regulations applicable to the athletes of that State. The State Rifle Associations/units may also charge an additional fee equal to entry fee of the competition but not more than Rs. 5000/- for forwarding the entries of Life/Annual Members of NRAI. This is applicable when these athletes are not members of State/Unit or any District/club to which Members of NRAI wish to represent. The Members of NRAI must have achieved MQS as defined for each competition under NRAI Match Book.



11. AGE CRITERIA

Athletes, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2025, will be allowed to participate under following age categories matches:

ATHLETES BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP.

12. ELIGIBILITY

Athletes qualified, as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are eligible to participate in this NSCC. (as per ANNEXURE 'B')

In case athlete is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the athlete and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The athlete will be allowed to participate in other events of the NSCC only after payment of penalty amount.

13. ENTRY

Entries of athletes who have State approved shooter ID will be accepted.

The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units and only through "NRAI's ONLINE SYSTEM". No paper entry will be accepted. The athletes are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee.

Please Note if you are sharing a weapons with another person, please send email to indiashooting@gmail.com by 21 November, 2025 with the name of the Individual with whom you are sharing your weapon and your event as per your competitor card.

- a. Athletes may send email to NRAI office for any assistance on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com
- b. Youth, Juniors can also participate in senior category with the payment of additional entry fee as per rules.
- c. Athletes, who achieve ISSF MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book will be notified as "Renowned Shooter".
- d. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid "online" only and no cash/draft will be accepted. Athletes will be permitted to shoot only in the details and Squads allotted to them.
- e. **Foreign Nationals must participate in matches, specifically for Foreign Nationals and are not permitted to participate in National Championship matches. In case of any violation, the athlete will be disqualified from participation in this NSCC.**

15. TEAM REPRESENTATION

Team events will be conducted in accordance with Rule 18 of NRAI Match Book. Only one Team from each State/ Unit will be allowed in each event irrespective of the number of participants in National Championship Category. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 17.00 hrs. on **our online portal** www.thenrai.org

NO TEAM EVENTS IN THE YOUTH, SUPER AND SENIOR MASTER CATEGORY.

The Mixed Team events will be conducted as per ISSF Rules. All affiliated units which wish to enter must file their entries as under online system. Only one team, consisting of one male and one female of the same state/unit, can be fielded. Entry fee is Rs. 6000/-(plus 18% GST = Rs.7080/-) per team.

16. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

The Protests and appeals will be dealt as per ISSF & NRAI Match Book. The Protest fee is Rs. 200/- plus 18% GST = Rs.236/- and in case of appeal to Jury of Appeal, the protest fee is Rs. 500/- plus 18% GST = Rs.590/-).

17. AMMUNITION

- a. The ammunition will be issued to the Team Manager only against cash payment on valid Arms Licenses of Associations/ Clubs/ Individuals or proper special permit issued by the Licensing Authorities. In case of inadequate authorization, special permits for the required quantity are obtained from the Local Licensing Authorities. Unused rounds and empties of used rounds are to be returned to NRAI without any exception.
- b. **In exceptional circumstances, the Director of Competition may permit the use of a common weapon. The names and competitor numbers of athletes intending to use a common weapon must be submitted to the Director of Competition at least two (2) days prior to the commencement of pre-event training, to enable necessary arrangements for the conduct of the respective matches.**

18. ACCOMMODATION

Participants are requested to kindly make their own arrangements for accommodation. A wide range of hotels for all budgets are available in New Delhi

- 19. MEDALS** Individual and Team medals will be awarded as under: -
- 3 medals where there is a minimum of 4 entries.
 - 2 medals where there is a minimum of 3 entries.
 - 1 medal where there is a minimum of 2 entries.

No prize will be awarded in case of a single entry, but organizers may award memento to the Athlete. The said rule will not apply in case of **Deaf, Para athletes, Senior master's and Super Masters** categories. Foreign Nationals may be awarded souvenirs

Medals/Badges will not be awarded to those, whose score is less than the qualifying marks as prescribed for the relevant matches irrespective of their individual position. The grading of those securing above the qualifying marks will be done as usual. **This will not apply to the athletes under Deaf, Para, Senior Masters and Super Masters category. (AS PER RULE NO. 10.3 OF NRAI MATCH BOOK)**



20. GENERAL

- a. All participants are requested to go through the above instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
- b. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competition. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
- c. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries will not be allowed any refund of the Entry Fee.
- d. Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules.
- e. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited. In case of any violation, disciplinary action shall be initiated and athlete may be debarred from taking part in NSCC.
- f. Accompanying person/personal coaches are not permitted to enter the Field of Play (FOP).
- g. The Organizers will have the right to close any match or event in case of any emergency or otherwise without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
- h. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by the Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.
- i. Scores of this NSCC will be considered for selection of National Squad and international competitions under the Selection Criteria, which will be published before the start of the NSCC.
- j. The Selection of National Squad and international teams will be done in accordance with the Selection Policy.
- k. No request for any adjustment shall be entertained. The details of squads will be notified on the website of NRAI. Athletes are required to enter the range 90 minutes before the reporting time at range so that they can report on time for their detail.
- l. **Mr. Arvinder Brar, father of Late Mr. Namanveer Singh Brar has announced a cash award of Rs. 31000/- to the athlete who shoots the highest QUALIFICATION SCORE in Trap Senior Men event and Rs.11000/- the highest QUALIFICATION SCORE in Trap Senior Women Event. The award amount will be paid by Mr. Arvinder Brar directly to the athlete.**

21. CODE OF CONDUCT

- a. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
- b. Be respectful towards fellow athletes, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of NRAI.
- c. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
- d. Follow directions by officials.
- e. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
- f. Be disciplined on and off the field.
- g. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
- h. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions/display.
- i. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
- j. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
- k. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
- l. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
- m. It's the responsibility of the athlete to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
- n. Athlete is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
- o. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
- p. In case of any grievance, please contact the Director of Competition, as per details given below.



- q. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow athletes, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
- r. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
- s. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.
