IMPORT OF ODD BORE AMMUNITION

Under clause 2.43 (a) of Handbook of Procedures 2023 of DGFT, the DGFT has authorized import of ammunition of only following Caliber's:-

- (i) Shotgun Cartridges 28 bore;
- (ii) Revolver Cartridges of .450, .455 and .45 bores
- (iii) Pistol Cartridges of .25, .30 Mauser, .450 and .45 bores
- (iv) Rifle Cartridges of 6.5 mm, .22 savage, .22 Hornet, 300 Sherwood, 32/40, .256, .275, .280, 7m/m Mauser, 7 m/m Man Schoener, 9m/m Mauser, 9 m/m Man Schoener, 8x57, 8x57S, 9.3 m/m, 9.5 m/m, .375 Magnum, .405, .30.06, .270, .30/30 Winch, .318, .33 Winch, .275 Mag., .350 Mag., 400/350, .369 Purdey, .450/400, .470, .32 Win, .458 Win, .380 Rook, .220 Swift and .44 Win. bores.

Members are requested to send their fresh indent for ammunition with quantity for the Caliber's as mentioned above so that the Import Permit is obtained from the DGFT. Please note that the Custom Duty, GST and etc will be applicable at the time of issue of ammunition.

Members can send their indent for the ammunition as per authorized Caliber/quantity on their Arm Licence. The indent for other calibers will not be accepted.
