## DECISIONS BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF NRAI IN ITS MEETING HELD ON 15 FEBRUARY 2025

## 1. Amendments in NRAI Match Book 2024

2	16.15	The State Rifle Associations/Units will be imposed a penalty of Rs. 3000/- (plus GST) per shooter in case their shooters score below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during All India G V Mavlankar Shooting Championship/Zonal Championships. The State/Unit must deposit the penalty amount with NRAI immediately otherwise shooters from that unit/state will not be allowed to participate in any competition conducted by NRAI. The Secretary General may also call explanation of the unit/state for sending such shooters. Shooters participating in AIGVMSC/Zonal Championships based on their performance during any competition conducted by NRAI shall be exempted.	If a shooter fails to achieve a minimum of 85% of the Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) under NRAI Match Book Clause 1.4, in AIGVMSC/ZONAL/INDIA OPEN COMPETITON a penalty of Rs. 3000/- plus GST will be imposed. This penalty shall be collected from the shooter through the State Rifle Association that approved their entry. The affiliated unit is responsible for ensuring the penalty is paid by the shooter. Until the penalty is paid, the shooter will not be permitted to participate in any NRAI-sanctioned competitions. This rule shall apply only once on first participation by a shooter on the basis of score achieved in a State Competition.
3	16.17	The shooters participating in shooting competitions should appear like sports persons and no unsporting clothing should be used by the shooters and they should come to the ranges/prize distribution with proper uniform. The following shall not be used by the shooters during shooting competitions:  Chappals and sandals Jeans Sleeveless tops/mini skirts  All type of pants and shorts with external pockets like cargo pants and shorts. 4	17.6	A shooter is eligible to compete in NSCC or any competition approved by the Governing Body of NRAI if he/she has scored a minimum of following scores in respective events during the previous NSCC/National Games/AIGVMSC/ZONAL CHAMPIONSHIP/INTER SCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP or any other competition approved by the Governing Body of NRAI. Scores of National Games should not be older than two years.

**2.** The NRAI will conduct zonal workshops by the NRAI nominated experts for the technical officials who officiate during NRAI competitions/trials to update the latest rules of ISSF.

## 3. Participation by shooters with approved Shooter ID:

No shooter, with unapproved ID, will be allowed to participate in any pre-national competition like AIGVMSC/ZONAL/INDIA OPEN COMPETITION. Those shooters, whose Shooter ID approval is pending with their State Rifle Association, are advised to contact them for approval of ID.

- 4. It has been decided to provide ammunition to all finalists of Olympic events during NSCC, free of charge. Efforts will be made to provide preferred lot/brand of ammunition of shooters choice.
- 5. The shooters, who achieved Big Bore MQS as per Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book during 61/62 NSCC held in 2019 and South Zone Shooting Championship 2020, will be allowed to participate in 67 NSCC. Rest of the shooters who desire to participate in 67 NSCC (Big Bore) must participate in India Open Competition and AIGVMSC to achieve MQS. The schedule of this championship will be notified shortly.
