
Please note the following points:

1. The selection trials will start tentatively at 10 AM.
2. These trials will be organized and conducted by the NRAI. On the recommendations of the Technical Committee, the shooters as per list attached – Annexure “A” are only permitted to participate in these trials
3. **THE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED “NRAI’s ONLINE SYTEM” and no paper entry will be accepted. The shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 9.30 PM on 31st December 2020. Entry Fee for both selection trials is Rs. 9,900/-**

4. There will be a total of two selection trials. The FAS as on 18th March 2020 would be the base score. The ranking lists are available on our website www.thenrai.in. The selection of teams will be done as per the Selection Policy 2019-20, which has now been extended till the time 64 NSCC is conducted. The scores of these selection trials will be considered for selection of team for ISSF World Cup, Egypt and ISSF World Cup, India
5. Rajiv Gandhi Khel Ratna Awardee / Arjuna Awardee will be allowed to participate in these trials irrespective of their ranking.
6. All the Shooters are requested to arrange their own ammunition. However, the same will be available against payment and valid arms license.
7. The Selection Committee has the right to select the final team for these Competitions.
8. Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/NRAI/. Copy of SOPs laid down by NRAI is attached herewith for your ready reference as per Annexure “B”.
9. All shooters/coaches must undergo a COVID-19 test prior to entering the range for first trial and submit a negative report from a Govt. certified lab to NRAI. This report should not be older than 48 hours from the date of first trial.
10. Only one person will be allowed to accompany the shooter subject to production of valid negative COVID – 19 report.
