Sub: XXVIII All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship 2026 in (Air Weapon) events at MP State Shooting Academy, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh from 30th August to 3rd September, 2026.

Dear Sir,

This is to inform you that the XXVIII All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship 2026 in Air Weapon events will be held at MP State Shooting Academy, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh from 30th August to 3rd September, 2026. It will be conducted by Madhya Pradesh State Rifle Association under the patronage of NRAI, as per the program attached at Annexure A”. Athletes from all over the country are invited to participate in this Championship. The terms and conditions are as under: -

1. The competition is open to school students all over the country in individual and team events.
2. Students will represent their respective State Rifle Associations.
3. All the affiliated units are advised to conduct their State level Inter School Shooting Competitions using “Online Software of NRAI to enable the athletes to file their entries for this Championship. The athletes who achieve the following MQS, during State Inter School Shooting Championship or any competition recognized by NRAI, are eligible to participate in this Championship: -

National Rule Matches 300/400 (Rifle and Pistol)

Athletes, who participated in 67th /68th NSCC and achieved the MQS, as required under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, are not eligible to participate in National Rule matches.

4. Athletes, who have not received/ applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.org to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.
5. The representation and entry for participation in **XXVIII All India Kumar Surendra Singh Inter School Shooting Championship in Air weapon events** is as per Rule 6 of NRAI Match Book. The athlete would represent the State as per their registration on NRAI’s “Online system”. Entries will be accepted on NRAI portal www.thenrai.org The last dates for accepting entries are as under:

With normal fee	—	20 th August, 2026 till 7.30 pm
With triple fee	—	21 st August, 2026 till 7.30 pm

ALLOCATION OF DETAILS Athletes are required to select their details, as per their choice and convenience through NRAI portal www.thenrai.org. The details will be posted on the website of NRAI www.thenrai.in. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. **NO REPLIES SHALL BE SENT BY NRAI FOR CHANGE OF DETAILS**

6. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid “online” and no cash/draft will be accepted. Athletes will be permitted to shoot only in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. Protest fee is Rs. 200/- (Plus 18% GST = Rs.236)

7. Team events will be conducted in National Rule (NR) Matches only. Teams can be formed by the athletes of same State and only one team consisting of three athletes per State will be allowed in each event. Final entry of three members of the team must be submitted latest by 5 PM on 29th August, 2026 at **NRAI online system**.

9. Athletes below the age, stated below, as on 31st December, 2026 will be eligible to participate in various age categories matches.

Juniors – below the age of 19 years

Youth – below the age of 18 years

Sub Youth – below the age of 15 years

FOR PARA ATHLETES

Athlete who achieves MQS as per Annexure “B” will be eligible to participate in 69th NSCC. Athletes who achieve MQS as per Annexure “B” will be notified as “Renowned Shooter “and they will also be eligible for grant of Import permit for Import of their equipment’s. List of NR Matches as per Annexure “B attached.

All Athletes, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category.

FOR DEAF ATHLETES

There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf athletes may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf athletes.

Participation in Deaf category is restricted to athletes who must be Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 db PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard)

1. Athletes wanting to participate in Deaf category for the first time have to email their Disability Certificate/Audiogram from Govt. Hospital to Technical Director/Coach, email ID anujajung@gmail.com or WhatsApp Mobile Number 09868206320, for verification by Coach and AISCD (All India Sport Council of the Deaf)
2. Athletes whose disability certificates have been verified earlier do not need to verify again.
3. Entry in Deaf category will be accepted online. Email match no. to anujajung@gmail.com verification of documents.
4. Deaf athletes can also participate in General category events as per MQS achieved, for the event to participate in. Entry in General Category should be submitted directly on the NRAI’s online system.
5. Scores achieved by deaf athletes in General category will be considered for MQS in Deaf category.

10. Those athletes, who are taking part in ISSF matches and are members of the Core Group, are not allowed to take part in National Rule Matches.

11. Athletes who have taken part in international competitions are not allowed to take part in this Competition.

12. Athletes achieving MQS as per “Annexure B” in NR Matches will be allowed to participate in 69th NSCC.

13. Athletes can take part in one category i.e. Junior, Youth or Sub Youth. Individual and team medals will be awarded as under: -

1. 3 medals where there is a minimum of 4 entries
2. 2 medals where there is a minimum of 3 entries
3. 1 medal where there is a minimum of 2 entries
4. No medal in case there is a single entry

14. The competition will be conducted according to ISSF Rules and NRAI Match Book.

15. No arms and air pellets will be provided to the competitors by NRAI. Athletes will arrange their own arrangement of Air Weapons and Air pellets.

16. The details/lanes would be allotted in the name of State Rifle Associations and not to individual athletes. All the participating States/Unit should officially nominate a Team Manager for the championship and he should ensure that details/lanes allotted to state/unit are allocated to the athletes without any inconvenience. The Team Manager or his/her authorized representative only will attend the Managers meetings, submit protests, if any, and be sole in-charge of day-to-day affairs of the team concerned. Scoring protest can be lodged by the concerned athletes also.

17. The list of Matches and Entry fee attached as per “Annexure C”.

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Be a responsible human being and a committed sports person.
2. Be respectful towards fellow athlete, officials, Coaches, support staff and staff of working at ranges
3. Be punctual and diligent and adhere schedule timings.
4. Follow directions by officials.
5. Shall be dressed appropriately in a dress code prescribed by ISSF.
6. Be disciplined on and off the field.
7. Must not verbally abuse or intimidate in any form such as shouting making gesture, towards or in any other way distract any spectator, tournament official, technical official, opposing coach or opposing team official, or opposing player
8. Shall not indulge in any political or religious and other discourse/discussions.
9. Should not make any inappropriate or unwanted physical, verbal, or sexual advance towards anyone.
10. Adhere to rules as set by Govt. of India/Sports Authority of India/NRAI or any agency related to the Championship.
11. Shall abide by the Code of Ethics of ISSF.
12. Should not consume alcohol or tobacco at range.
13. It's the responsibility of the athlete to be aware of all the rules and be responsible for their equipment being as per ISSF regulations.
14. Athlete is responsible for following all rules/norms and go through the notices issued by NRAI at Range/Website of NRAI.
15. Adhere WADA/NADA rules and not to use drugs, which are not permitted under WADA/NADA rules.
16. In case of any grievance, please contact **the Competition**, as per details given below.
17. Shall not interact with media in any form or over any print/electronic/social platform or post any material, which is contrary to the spirit of IOC Charter, ISSF Rules, shooting sport, fellow athletes, coaches, other office bearers of NRAI and against the policies of Govt. of India/SAI/NRAI.
18. Must not bring the shooting sport into disrepute through media that relate to tournament officials, technical officials, opposing coaches or team officials and or players, that are personal in nature, imply bias, or question their integrity.
19. Violation of above may lead to cancellation of entry of this Championship.

The NRAI/Organizing Committee reserve the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by NRAI/Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules. Half pants/Jeans and chapels are not permitted on the range.
