3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup Final will be conducted according to the actual ISSF Rules and Regulations – Detailed Information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org

NO ISSF World Ranking points will be distributed for the ISSF World Cup Final 2024.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS Jury, Shotgun and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup Final. Qualified Range Officials holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle/Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition.subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control or inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated, and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, theathlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue wearing this clothing for that day of the event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified.

Air or CO2 Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO2 cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial on their marker tapes. Any shooting vest that does not have ISSF seals on the marker tape must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-Competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing duringthe competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Cartridges Control

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by acomputer draw. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50 g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weighs more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Before the Final, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalist or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Final and place them in separate Cartridges Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 30 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes. The boxes mustbe left and sealed under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is Placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples fromthose cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridges' controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals (there will be no elimination for 6th place; the first elimination will be for 5th place).

Colored Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

5. Shooting Range

The ISSF World Cup will take place at the Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Tughlakabad, New Delhi, India.

Rifle/Pistol

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

Range	Description
10m hall	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
25m range	50 firing points (10 groups); electronic targets, SIUS AG
50m range	80 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG
Finals hall	10 firing points, electronic targets, SIUS AG

The firing direction of the 25m and 50m range is north.

Shotgun

The shooting range has five (5) combined ranges for Trap / Skeet and one (1) separate range for dry firing and gun testing.

The shooting range is equipped with Laporte machines and acoustic release system.

The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic release system.

All ranges are equipped with electronic scoreboards.

The firing direction of the shooting range is north.

The targets used for the ISSF World Cup Final are Euro target, standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Final.

As per immigration laws in India, visa for participants from (1) Afghanistan, (2) Iraq, (3) Pakistan, (4) Sudan, (5) Foreigners of Pakistan origin and (6) Stateless persons can be issued only after Ministry of Home (MHA) clearance. Therefore, online application for Visa must be made at least 60 days in advance by the participants of these countries. Further, ISSF Member Federations from these countries should send information about participants in the following format at least 60 days in advance to facilitate visa process:

If the number of participants from/above mentioned countries is more than 15, the information should be provided in soft copy (in excel) (.xls format) also.

Applications/list of participants from the above-mentioned countries not submitted in time are liable to be summarily rejected.

Gun Permits

All athletes must declare the firearms and ammunition to be brought into India and return to the Organizing Committee the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) no later than **12th September 2024**. Please submit the form fully completed, signed and stamped by the federation.

Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect forms will be returned, unprocessed.

On arrival at airport, the participants must produce Annex 6 (in triplicate) to the Custom authorities for verification of firearms and ammunition.

All participating federations are advised to book their flight directly to Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. Reception and clearance of guns and ammunition will ONLY be arranged at the Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi.

7. Accommodation

8. Travel and Transportation

Travel-Arrival and Departure

Participating federations will be met and facilitated on arrival at Indira Gandhi International Airport, New Delhi. Teams will then clear immigration and security controls.

The Organizing Committee will arrange an airport pick-up/transfer service free of charge during the days of the World Cup Final from 13th to 18th October 2024 and participants are requested to submit the arrival and departure details on time (completed official Final Travel Form –Annex 2). In case of early arrival, the pick-up service can be arranged at a charge. Kindly note that assistance at the airport for the firearms will be granted free of charge regardless of the arrival date.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

While in India, all guns and ammunition must be stored in the armory at the shooting range. Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately should carry a signed and stamped copy of the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 6) while both entering and departing India. The storage of guns and ammunition in hotel and outside the shooting range is strictly prohibited. Armory will be open to facilitate the arrival of official teams until departure.

10. Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on 14th September 2024, at the Finals Hall. Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup Final. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

11. Doping Control Tests

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules under the supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

12. Weather Information

Temperatures during the period range from 24°C to 33°C. Average sunlight is 12 hours/day.
