Sub: 43RD North Zone Shooting Championship in 10M AIR RIFLE Events (NR) at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, New Delhi from 20th to 25th November, 2024.

The 43rd North Zone Shooting Championship 2024 in **10M AIR RIFLE** events will be held at Dr. Karni Singh Shooting Ranges, Tughlakabad, New Delhi from 20th to 25th November, 2024. This championship will be conducted by **Haryana Rifle Association** under the aegis of the National Rifle Association of India and as per rules and regulations under NRAI Match Book. Those competitors, who want to participate in this competition, are requested to go through the following instructions carefully for their own convenience and to ensure smooth and successful conduct of the above competitions.

This Championship is open to shooters belonging to the States under North Zone only as stated above. Shooters from other States are not permitted to participate in this Championship in any match including for achieving MQS score as Guest Shooter. The shooters from paramilitary forces, AI, ONGC and other affiliated units of NRAI, who are domicile or having posting in the States mentioned above shall be eligible to represent their unit or state with the prior written permission from NRAI. Shooters, who have achieved MQS as per Rule 1.4 of NRAI Match Book during State Championship, are allowed to take part in NR Matches only.

SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 12 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FIRE ARM MATCHES DURING THIS CHAMPIONSHIP. SIMILARLY, SHOOTERS BELOW THE AGE OF 10 YEARS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN AIR WEAPON EVENTS.

Shooters, who participated in previous NSCC but failed to achieve MQS under 17.6 of NRAI Match Book, must file their entry in MQS category failing which they will be disqualified as per Rule 10.6 of NRAI Match Book. Shooters, who participated in 65th /66th NSCC and achieved the MQS, as required under Rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book are eligible to participate only in ISSF Matches. This is subject to conduct of ISSF Matches by the Organizers.

Shooters, who achieved MQS as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book 2024 in 65th /66th NSCC are not eligible to participate in MQS or other category in Zonal or AIGVMSC.

Shooters, who have not received/applied for their Shooter ID number, must immediately visit our website www.thenrai.in to check status/apply for their Shooter ID number.

Shooters, who are completing the age, as stated below in 2024, will be allowed to participate under age categories matches:

Juniors – 21 yearsBorn in 2003 or after.Youth - 19 years or beforeBorn in 2005 or afterSub Youth - 16 years or beforeBorn in 2008 or after

Masters -45 - 60 years

Should have completed 45 years one day before Competition
Senior Masters -60 - 70 years

Should have completed 60 years one day before Competition
Super Masters -70 years

Should have completed 70 years one day before Competition.

The entries will be accepted through respective affiliated State Rifle Association/Units only. THE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED via "NRAI's ONLINE SYSTEM" and no paper entry will be accepted. The Shooters are required to visit our website www.thenrai.org to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with normal fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 8th November, 2024. Late entries with triple entry fee will be accepted till 7.30 PM on 11th November, 2024.

In case any Shooter/Affiliated unit need any assistance for filing the entry, he/she must approach NRAI immediately BUT before 5 PM on 8th November, 2024, so that their entries are accepted with normal fee. Shooters contacting for assistance after 8th November, 2024 are liable to pay triple fee. Shooters may also send email on email ID indiashooting@gmail.com

Shooters achieving scores as per rule 17.6 of NRAI Match Book will be allowed to participate in 67th NSCC. Entry fee will not be refunded except in the event of the match being cancelled. The entry fee should be paid "online" and no cash/draft will be accepted. Shooters will be permitted to shoot only in the details and lanes allotted to them. No requests regarding change of firing points/relays/dates will be entertained. Protest fee is Rs. 300/-(plus 18% GST = Rs.354/-). A sum of Rs. 200/- (plus 18% GST = Rs.236/-) will be charged if a shooter loses his/her competitor card during the competition and fresh card will only be issued on deposit of amount.

The State Rifle Associations/Units will be imposed a penalty of Rs. 3000/-(plus 18% GST = Rs.3540/-) per shooter in case their shooters score below 15% of the qualifying score as per NRAI Match Book rule 1.4 during Zonal Championship under Rule 16.15 of NRAI Match Book. The State/Unit must remit the penalty amount with NRAI immediately otherwise shooters from that unit/state will not be allowed to participate in any competition conducted by NRAI. The Secretary General may also call for explanation of the unit/state for sending such shooters. Shooters participating in AIGVMSC on the basis of their performance during any competition conducted by NRAI shall be exempted.

In case shooter is not qualified in a particular event and adds his/her entry that event on the portal of NRAI, a penalty of Rs. 5000/- (plus GST, as applicable) shall be imposed on the shooter and will not be allowed to participate in that event. The shooter will be allowed to participate in other events of the NSCC only after payment of penalty amount.

IMPORTANT

Only three (3) shooters will be allowed to use common weapon. The names of shooters likely to use common weapon should be intimated together with the weapon number to the Organizing Secretary in advance to enable to work out the details for the conduct of the relevant matches.

AWARD OF MEDALS

The medals will be awarded in individual category as follows:

- 4 shooters 3 Medals
- 3 Shooters 2 Medals
- 2 shooters 1 Medal
- 1 shooter no Medal

Senior and Super master's category shooters are exempted from above

(DEAF SHOOTERS)

For Deaf shooters – There will be only one age category – Men and Women. However, Deaf shooters may participate in other category matches according to their age but there no separate medal will be awarded under those categories to Deaf shooters.

Participation in Deaf category is restricted to shooters who must be Deaf, defined as a hearing loss of at least 55 db PTA in the better ear (3-tone frequency average at 500, 1000 and 2000 Hertz, air conduction ISO 1969 Standard)

- 1. Shooters wanting to participate in Deaf category for the first time have to email their Disability Certificate/Audiogram from Govt. Hospital to Technical Director/Coach, email ID anujajung@gmail.com or Whats app, Mobile Number 09868206320, for verification by Coach and AISCD (All India Sport Council of the Deaf)
- 2. Shooters whose disability certificates have been verified earlier do not need to verify again.
- 3. Entry in Deaf category will be accepted ONLINE. Email match no. to anujajung@gmail.com verification of documents.
- 4. Deaf shooters can also participate in General category events as per MQS achieved, for the event to participate in. Entry in General Category should be submitted directly on the NRAI's online system.

5. Scores achieved by deaf shooters in General category will be considered for MQS in Deaf category.

(PARA SHOOTERS)

For Para Shooters - All Shooters, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category

Shooter who achieves MQS as per Annexure will be eligible to participate in 67^h NSCC. Shooters who achieve MQS as per Annexure will be notified as "Renowned Shooter "and they will also be eligible for grant of Import permit for Import of their equipment's.

All Shooters, who are already registered, are also required to upload their medical categorization certificate as approved by PCI, if not done earlier. Without a medical categorization certificate, no entry will be accepted under Para Category

The NRAI/Organizing Committee reserve the right to amend the rules at any time at its sole discretion for events/circumstances beyond its control. Any decision made by NRAI/Organizing Committee in any such matter will be final. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the competitions. Discipline on and off the field is very essential. Shooting practice in hotels is strictly prohibited.

Shooting kit (clothing & Equipment) of the competitors during the competition will be strictly according to ISSF Rules. Half pants/Jeans and chappals are not permitted on the range.

COVID PROTOCOLS

Due to COVID – 19 conditions, shooters are requested to strictly follow SOPs as laid down by Govt. of India/Delhi Govt.
