CIRCULAR FOR SELECTION OF DEAF SHOOTERS FOR 2ND WORLD DEAF SHOOTING CHAMPIONSHIP

The AISCD has decided to conduct selection trials for selection of teams for the 2nd World Deaf Shooting Championship to be held at Hanover, Germany from August 29 to September 08, 2024.

A total of 3 scores will be considered for selection. Registered deaf shooters who have/will achieve the trial MQS score for Deaf shooters as per annexure 'A' in 66th NSCC / 22nd Kumar Surendra Singh Championship will only be eligible for participation in the selection trials.

The first score will be the score achieved in the 22nd Kumar Surendra Singh Competition conducted by NRAI from June 01 to 19, 2024 in Bhopal. (**Deaf Shooters can participate in the above competition under regular ISSF rules using hearing aids**)

2 more scores will be considered from a double selection trial which will be announced & conducted at a later date. (Shooters will have to shoot the above double trials without hearing aids)

Finals will not be conducted for deaf trials.

From the above 3 scores, shooters will be ranked according to the average of best two scores.

In case of shooter having only two scores, average of two scores will be considered for ranking. Shooter having only one score will not be considered for ranking and selection.

A cut off score for selection in all events will be announced before the commencement of the 22nd Kumar Surendra Singh Championship.

The top 3 ranked shooters having an average equal to or above cut off score in each event will be eligible to be selected for the championship, subject to approval and sanction from SAI regarding maximum number of shooters to be selected.

Deaf shooters who have achieved Trial MQS score in 66th NSCC are hereby informed to participate in the 22nd Kumar Surendra Singh Championship in Deaf Category to be considered for selection. Shooters who have not yet achieved the Trial MQS score in 66th NSCC can try to achieve it in the 22nd Kumar Surendra Singh Championship and be eligible to participate in the double trials that will follow.
